MUSIC CITY TIPOFF

- For the first time since 2014, Vanderbilt opens its season against a fellow Nashville resident as the Commodores welcome Lipscomb to Memorial Gymnasium.
- The Dores hosted Trevecca in the 2014 season opener and followed by hosting the Bisons in game two of the schedule - also the most recent time the Dores and Bisons have met on the hardwood.
- The Commodores have faced Music City foes seven times to tip a season, holding a perfect 7-0 record in those matchups.
- Vanderbilt and Lipscomb meet for the first time since 2014 and the 29th time in program history. The Dores lead the all-time series 24-4 and have won nine straight dating to 1951 and 23-of-24 dating to 1940-41.

THE THREE MUSKATEERS COMMODORES

- Vanderbilt returns a trio of impact players from the 2024-25 roster in Devin McGlockton, Tyler Nickel and Tyler Tanner.
- McGlockton was a force on the boards, ranking fourth in the SEC in rebounds per game (7.9) and third in the league in offensive boards per contest (3.1). He also finished third on the squad averaging 10.3 points in 2024-25.
- Nickel established himself as one of the best sharpshooters in the country, hitting at .405 from three for the season. The mark ranked 36th nationally and second in the SEC.
- In league action, Nickel was the best three-point shooter in the SEC, nailing 45.2% of his attempts in SEC play.
- Tanner dazzled in his first collegiate action as the freshman opened the season with 320 minutes of turnover-free basketball - the most by any player since at least 1996-97.
- Tanner also set the Vanderbilt freshman record and led all high-major freshmen with 55 steals last season.

STARTING EXPERIENCE

- Vanderbilt enters the 2025-26 campaign as one of the most experience squads in the nation. The Commodores have nine players who have started 30 or more games at the DI level in their careers.
- The nine Dores have started a combined 519 games while the roster as whole owns 536 starts at the collegiate level.
- Duke Miles (86), Devin McGlockton (79) and Frankie Collins (76) all have over 75 starts in their collegiate careers.
- Vandy's 536 starts are the second most in the country, trailing only Indiana who has 554 starts on its roster.

DORES RETURN TO DANCE

- Vanderbilt returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2017 and the 16th time overall.
- The Commodores finished the season 20-13 overall after falling in the round of 64 to Saint Mary's.
- All 20 of Vandy's wins came in the regular season, marking the most regular season victories under a first-year head coach in program history.
- Vanderbilt closed the season with 15-straight games against NCAA Tournament teams.

PRESEASON VOTES

- Vanderbilt begins the 2025-26 season just outside of the AP Top 25, receiving seven votes in the preseason poll.
- The Dores reached the Top 25 for the first time since 2016 last season, reaching No. 24 in the Jan. 27 poll.

**ANALYTICS DARLING**

- Vanderbilt is a favorite among the numerous computer rankings in college basketball heading into the 2025-26 season.
- KenPom has the Dores ranked 19th nationally with the No. 19 offense and No. 23 defense in college basketball.
- EvanMiya has Vandy slotted 24th with the 16th-best offensive rating.
- Bart Torvik has the Commodores 20th overall and tabs the offense as the ninth-best in the nation heading into the season. The Dores are the highest rated SEC offense in Torvik's system.

**GROWING UP (LITERALLY)**

- Vanderbilt spent the 2024-25 season as an undersized roster, ranking 298th in KenPom's average height ranking which includes minutes played into the equation.
- The Commodores were the third-shortest high major roster in the ranking in 2024-25.
- This season, Vanderbilt's average height has grown from 76.1 inches to 78.2 among the expected rotation. That mark would have ranked in the top 50 last season.
- Vanderbilt's roster features seven players listed at 6-foot-7 or taller in 2025-26.

**NEW TEAM, PLENTY OF FAMILIARITY**

- Vanderbilt added 11 new players to the roster for the 2025-26 campaign, but there's plenty of connections among the new arrivals.
- Jalen Washington joins the Dores after three seasons at North Carolina. The versatile big was recruited to Nashville by Tyler Nickel, who played with Washington during the pair's freshman season in Chapel Hill.
- Washington was also high school teammates with Mason Nicholson at Gary West Side in Gary, Ind. The pair are reunited after last playing together in a 22-5 season and Indiana state semifinal run.
- The Commodores faced both Duke Miles and Frankie Collins during regular season action in 2024-25.

**NEW DUKE IN TOWN**

- Duke Miles is no stranger to the SEC but the sixth-year guard looks poised for another breakout.
- Miles topped 20 points in each of Vanderbilt's exhibition games after doing so just once last season at Oklahoma while playing alongside Jeremiah Fears.
- Miles is a career .353 shooter from three-point range and .495 from the field.
- Miles has also produced 40 or more steals in each of his four full seasons at the collegiate level, including a career-high 48 last season at Oklahoma.

**HARRIS HITS**

- Newcomer Tyler Harris made a name for himself last season at Washington as one of the best three-point shooters in the country, connecting on 49.5% of his 91 triples last season.
- Harris led the country in three-point percentage among players who attempted more than 40 over the season.
- The winger averaged 11.8 ppg in 2024-25 while also leading the Huskies in blocked shots with 32.

**NICKEL IS GOLD**

- Tyler Nickel hit multiple three-pointers in five consecutive games to close the 2024-25 regular season.
- The junior hit four or more threes in eight games last season, including a career-high seven three-pointers to spark the Dores past No. 12 Texas A&M.
- He has hit 81 three-pointers on the season, falling just outside the top 10 in program history.
- The junior hit three or more triples 17 times last season with the Dores going 13-4 in those games.

**CORNELL PIPELINE?**

- For a second consecutive season, Vanderbilt welcomes a graduate transfer from Cornell to the roster as AK Okereke dons the black & gold.
- Okereke follows Chris Mañon who played the pivotal glue role in 2024-25 on his way to landing a roster spot with the Los Angeles Lakers.
- Okereke's story is plenty inspiring on its own - the Clovis, California, native arrived at Cornell as a regular student and economics major. He walked on following a tryout in late August 2022. He then graduated from Cornell in three years and excelled on the court, being named a team captain last season.
- Okereke averaged 13.9 ppg in 2024-25 for the Big Red while posting a 2.18 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking 18th nationally in field goal percentage.
- Okereke shot .595 from the floor and .321 from three-point range in his final season at Cornell.

**COLLINS ON THE COMEBACK**

- Frankie Collins has plenty of collegiate experience with stops at Michigan, Arizona State and TCU prior to his arrival in Nashville.
- His senior season at TCU was cut short after breaking his foot, ironically in the Coast-to-Coast Challenge against the Commodores last December. The injury sidelined the guard for the remainder of the season as he took a medical redshirt.
- Collins has been one of the best creators in college basketball, averaging 3.9 assists per game over the past three seasons. Through nine games in 2024-25, Collins was averaging 4.4 assists per contests, a career-best mark.

**ANOTHER COMEBACK STORY**

- Mike James is set to play his first official college basketball game in 600 days when the Commodores open the season on Monday night.
- James, who began his career at Louisville, missed the entirety of the 2024-25 season after a preseason knee injury and subsequent infection sidelined him at NC State.
- The missed season is the second of James' career, after an Achilles tear halted his freshman campaign before it began at Louisville in 2021-22.
- In two full seasons, James averaged 11.3 ppg at Louisville while shooting .348 from beyond the arc.

**TRUST IN GLOCK**

- Perhaps one of the most undervalued players in the country, Devin McGlockton simply helps the Dores win. It's not the flashiest basketball, but the veteran was an integral part of the NCAA Tournament squad.
- McGlockton is set to return to his more natural role as a four on the floor in 2025-26 after playing in the five spot all of last season.
- Even as an undersized five, McGlockton averaged 10.3 ppg and 7.9 reb last season. He ranked seventh in the SEC in total rebounding while finishing third with 3.12 offensive boards per game.
- The ever consistent McGlockton record 19 double-figure scoring games and 11 games with double digit rebounds.

**TANNER'S ROOKIE RECORD**

- With 55 steals last season, Tyler Tanner broke the Vanderbilt freshman record.
- He passed Wade Baldwin IV, who notched 50 steals in his freshman campaign in 2014-15.
- Tanner's 55 steals ranked 11th in Vanderbilt single-season history.
- Defensive pressure runs in the family as Tanner's father, D'Wayne, owns the Southwest Conference record with 291 career takeaways from his time at Rice. He also owns Rice's single-season record with 95.

HISTORIC TRIUMPHS

- Vanderbilt's back-to-back wins over No. 12 Texas A&M and No. 14 Mizzou marked the third and fourth victories over top 15 foes this season. It was the first time the Dores have defeated four top 15 teams in the same season since 1987-88.
- The Commodores also earned three-straight ranked wins in a seven-day span after topping Ole Miss, marking the first time Vandy knocked off three consecutive ranked opponents since 2007.
- The Dores produced five wins over ranked opponents this season which are the most since 2006-07 (6). It was only the second time in program history Vandy has defeated five ranked foes in the regular season.

ELITE DEPTH

- Vanderbilt head coach Mark Byington said preseason his squad is legitimately 8- or 9-deep and the analytics back him up.
- According to EvanMiya.com, Vanderbilt has the fourth-best depth in the country behind only Arkansas, Louisville and Michigan.
- Miyakawa's rankings are based on a comparison of the eighth-best player on the roster.

PRO DORES

- Five former Commodores dot NBA rosters this season with All-Star Darius Garland (CLE), Aaron Nesmith (IND), Scotty Pippen Jr. (MEM), Luke Kornet (SAS) and Chris Mañon (LAL) all in the association.
- Two more Dores were taken in the NBA Draft with AJ Hoggard going to Raptors 905 and Tyrin Lawrence taken by the CP Skyhawks.
- Four different Commodores have won a total of eight NBA Championships.
- 29 Commodores have reached the NBA in program history.

LONG ROAD IN NONCONFERENCE

- Vanderbilt's nonconference slate is a bit of a departure from the Power 4 norm. The black and gold will hit the road for three high-major road tests in November and December.
- The Dores' second game of the season is a road trip to UCF, marking the first time since 2018-19 Vandy travels within the first two games of the season.
- Vanderbilt has left the state for a true road game in the first two contests only five times since 1998-99.
- This is the first time since 2012-13 Vanderbilt will play three true road games in nonconference action and just the third occurrence this century.

FOUR TOP 15 TAKEDOWNS

- Vandy toppled a quartet of top 15 opponents with wins over then No. 6 Tennessee, No. 9 Kentucky, No. 12 Texas A&M and No. 14 Mizzou.
- The four top 15 victories mark the first time since 1987-88 the Dores have downed three or more top 15 foes.

RANKED WINS

- The Commodores toppled five ranked opponents in 2024-25, the most since 2006-07 for the black and gold.
- Vanderbilt conquered two top 10 foes in No. 6 Tennessee and No. 9 Kentucky in a seven-day span.
- The pair of top 10 wins marked the first time the Dores have beaten multiple top 10 foes in a season since 2007.

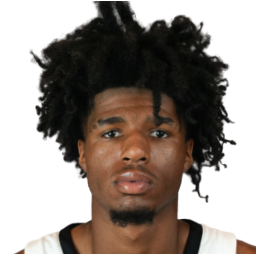
