### HISTORIC (HOT) START

- For the first time in program history, Vanderbilt opened the season with back-to-back 100-point
- Vanderbilt's pair of 105-point performances have the Commodores ranked 11th in the country in scoring.
- The Dores are one of four teams in the country to have multiple 100-point games against DI opponents to open the season. Vandy is the only one of those four to face a high-major opponent.
- The opening onslaught marks the first consecutive 100-point games since 1980 for Vanderbilt. The Dores put 111 on North Alabama and Memphis that December.
- The Commodores have never eclipsed the 100-point barrier in three-straight contests.

#### DOWNTOWN DOMINANCE

- Vanderbilt leads the SEC and ranks 14th nationally in three point shooting percentage at 46.3%.
- The Dores also lead the SEC and are tied for second in the country with 15.5 made threes per game.
- Tyler Nickel's five made threes per contest rank eighth nationally and also lead the SEC. Nickel is shooting 58.8% from three on the season, good for third in the SEC.
- Tyler Tanner ranks sixth in the SEC with 3.5 made triples per game to open the season.
- Five Dores (Nickel, Tanner, Harris, Miles, Okereke) have knocked down multiple threes through two games. The group is shooting 52.7% from three (29of-55).

## ANALYTICS ASSESSMENT

- Vanderbilt is a favorite among the numerous computer rankings through opening week.
- KenPom has the Dores ranked 15th nationally with the No. 5 offense.
- · EvanMiya has Vandy slotted 19th with the seventhbest offensive rating.
- Bart Torvik has the Commodores 15th overall and tabs the offense as the No. 2 attack in the nation.
- The Dores are the highest rated SEC offense in all three analytic systems.

- The Dores average 3.5 assists per turnover through two games, a mark which leads the SEC.
- Vanderbilt has committed just six turnovers in each game, also leading the SEC.
- Against UCF, the Dores did not commit a single liveball turnover. It marked the first time since 2016 a Commodore opponent did not record a steal.
- Duke Miles ranks third nationally with a 12.0 assistto-turnover ratio. Miles leads the SEC while teammate Frankie Collins ranks sixth in the league at 5.5 ast/to.
- Through two games, Vanderbilt has 42 assists on 76 made baskets. The mark ranks top 50 in the country.

#### THE TYFECTA

- Get your Spidey memes out... Vandy's trio of Tylers are a force on the floor as Tyler Harris, Tyler Nickel and Tyler Tanner all starred in the opening week of the season.
- The Tyfecta combined for 53 points and went 12-of-19 from three in the win over Lipscomb. Nickel led the way with 20, Tanner added 18 and Harris 15.
- · At UCF, all three Tylers were again in double figures, combining for 48 points.
- The trio owns 21 of Vanderbilt's 31 three-pointers on the year, shooting 52.5% from beyond the arc.
- We're fairly certain it's the most combined points by players named Tyler on the same team this season.

### NIGHT KNIGHT

- Vanderbilt stormed the castle on Saturday, blitzing UCF 105-93 in the second game of the season.
- The Dores hit 10 first half threes en route to a 52-36 edge at the break. Vanderbilt extend the advantage out to 27 before cruising to the road win.
- Five Dores scored in double figures for the second time to open the season, led by Duke Miles at 20.

#### **DUKE DIMES**

- Newcomer Duke Miles led the Dores in scoring in each of the two exhibition contests, but on opening night he powered the offense by delivering nine assists.
- The nine assists matched a career high for Miles and were the most by a Commodore since Ezra Manjon had nine against Kentucky in 2023.
- Miles' nine helpers led to 24 points for the Commodores.
- Duke added 10 points to narrowly miss his first career double-double
- Even more impressive, Miles did not commit a single turnover in the game while adding three steals in 25 minutes.

#### **CAPITALIZING ON TAKEAWAYS**

- Vanderbilt has 20 steals through two games to just three for its opponents. The Dores have committed just 12 total turnovers to 30 from opposition.
- The Commodores own a staggering 53-6 advantage in points off turnovers. Vandy outscored Lipscomb 33-4 off turnovers and UCF 20-2.

## **COLLINS CREATES**

- Veteran Frankie Collins has produced five and six assists in each of the first two contests. The 11 helpers are second on the team.
- Collins' 11 assists have created 27 points for the Commodores.
- He also leads the team with seven steals, which have led to another 10 points for the black and gold.
- Collins has also been effective crashing the glass with nine rebounds, good for second on the team.

#### **POLL TALK**

- Vanderbilt sits just outside the AP Top 25 with 37 points after the opening week of the season.
- Vandy gained 30 points in the poll from its Week 1 showing.
- The Dores reached the Top 25 for the first time since 2016 last season, reaching No. 24 in the Jan. 27 poll.
- Vandy is the highest vote getter outside the top 25 in the Coaches poll following Week 1.

### STRING MUSIC ON OPENING DAY

- Vanderbilt romped past fellow Music City resident Lipscomb 105-61 in the season opener.
- The Commodores lit up the scoreboard by shooting 55.9% from the field (38-of-68) and 54.8% from beyond the arc (17-of-31).
- The 105 points matched the most in a season opener in program history. The previous instance came back in 1975 when the Dores hung 105 on Iowa State to begin the year.
- Five Commodores scored in double figures with four topping the 15-point mark. Tyler Nickel led the way with 20, followed by Tyler Tanner at 18, AK Okereke at 16 and Tyler Harris at 15. Duke Miles added 10 points in the win
- Vandy's 17 made three-pointers were the most by the Dores since 2017 and tied for the third highest total in program history.
- The 44-point margin of victory was the largest season-opening spread since 1913 when the Dores downed MTSU 53-5.

### THE THREE MUSKATEERS COMMODORES

- Vanderbilt returns a trio of impact players from the 2024-25 roster in Devin McGlockton, Tyler Nickel and Tyler Tanner.
- McGlockton was a force on the boards in 24-25, ranking fourth in the SEC in rebounds per game (7.9) and third in the league in offensive boards per contest (3.1). He also finished third on the squad averaging 10.3 points in 2024-25.
- Nickel established himself as one of the best sharpshooters in the country, hitting at .405 from three

for the season. The mark ranked 36th nationally and second in the SEC.  $\,$ 

- In league action, Nickel was the best three-point shooter in the SEC, nailing 45.2% of his attempts in SEC play.
- Tanner dazzled in his first collegiate action as the freshman opened the season with 320 minutes of turnover-free basketball the most by any player since at least 1996-97.
- Tanner also set the Vanderbilt freshman record and led all high-major freshmen with 55 steals last season.

## STARTING EXPERIENCE

- Vanderbilt enters the 2025-26 campaign as one of the most experience squads in the nation. The Commodores have nine players who have started 30 or more games at the DI level in their careers.
- The nine Dores have started a combined 529 games while the roster as whole owns 546 starts at the collegiate level.
- Duke Miles (88), Devin McGlockton (81) and Frankie Collins (77) all have over 75 starts in their collegiate
- Vandy's 546 starts are the second most in the country, trailing only Indiana who has 564 starts on its roster.

#### **DORES RETURN TO DANCE**

- Vanderbilt returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2017 and the 16th time overall.
- The Commodores finished the season 20-13 overall after falling in the round of 64 to Saint Mary's.
- All 20 of Vandy's wins came in the regular season, marking the most regular season victories under a first-year head coach in program history.
- Vanderbilt closed the season with 15-straight games against NCAA Tournament teams.

## GROWING UP (LITERALLY)

- Vanderbilt spent the 2024-25 season as an undersized roster, ranking 298th in KenPom's average height ranking which includes minutes played into the equation.
- The Commodores were the third-shortest high major roster in the ranking in 2024-25.
- This season, Vanderbilt's average height has grown from 76.1 inches to 78.2 among the expected rotation. That mark would have ranked in the top 50 last season.
- Vanderbilt's roster features seven players listed at 6-foot-7 or taller in 2025-26.

#### **NEW TEAM, PLENTY OF FAMILIARITY**

- Vanderbilt added 11 new players to the roster for the 2025-26 campaign, but there's plenty of connections among the new arrivals.
- Jalen Washington joins the Dores after three seasons at North Carolina. The versatile big was recruited to Nashville by Tyler Nickel, who played with Washington during the pair's freshman season in Chapel Hill.
- Washington was also high school teammates with Mason Nicholson at Gary West Side in Gary, Ind. The pair are reunited after last playing together in a 22-5 season and Indiana state semifinal run.
- The Commodores faced both Duke Miles and Frankie Collins during regular season action in 2024-25.

#### **NEW DUKE IN TOWN**

**SEC STANDINGS** 

- Duke Miles is no stranger to the SEC but the sixth-year guard looks poised for another breakout.
- Miles topped 20 points in each of Vanderbilt's exhibition games after doing so just once last season at Oklahoma while playing alongside Jeremiah Fears.
- Miles is a career .353 shooter from three-point range and .495 from the field.
- Miles has also produced 40 or more steals in each of his four full seasons at the collegiate level, including a career-high 48 last season at Oklahoma.

#### HARRIS HITS

- Newcomer Tyler Harris made a name for himself last season at Washington as one of the best three-point shooters in the country, connecting on 49.5% of his 91 triples last season.
- Harris led the country in three-point percentage among players who attempted more than 40 over the season.
- The winger averaged 11.8 ppg in 2024-25 while also leading the Huskies in blocked shots with 32.

### **NICKEL IS GOLD**

- Tyler Nickel hit multiple three-pointers in five consecutive games to close the 2024-25 regular
- The junior hit four or more threes in eight games last season, including a career-high seven three-pointers to spark the Dores past No. 12 Texas A&M.
- He has hit 81 three-pointers on the season, falling just outside the top 10 in program history.
- The junior hit three or more triples 17 times last season with the Dores going 13-4 in those games.

### CORNELL PIPELINE?

- For a second consecutive season, Vanderbilt welcomes a graduate transfer from Cornell to the roster as AK Okereke dons the black & gold.
- Okereke follows Chris Mañon who played the pivotal glue role in 2024-25 on his way to landing a roster spot with the Los Angeles Lakers.
- Okereke's story is plenty inspiring on its own the Clovis, California, native arrived at Cornell as a regular student and economics major. He walked on following a tryout in late August 2022. He then graduated from Cornell in three years and excelled on the court, being named a team captain last season.
- Okereke averaged 13.9 ppg in 2024-25 for the Big Red while posting a 2.18 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking 18th nationally in field goal percentage.
- Okereke shot .595 from the floor and .321 from threepoint range in his final season at Cornell.

#### **COLLINS ON THE COMEBACK**

- Frankie Collins has plenty of collegiate experience with stops at Michigan, Arizona State and TCU prior to his arrival in Nashville.
- His senior season at TCU was cut short after breaking his foot, ironically in the Coast-to-Coast Challenge against the Commodores last December. The injury sidelined the guard for the remainder of the season as he took a medical redshirt.
- Collins has been one of the best creators in college basketball, averaging 3.9 assists per game over the past three seasons. Through nine games in 2024-25, Collins was averaging 4.4 assists per contests, a careerbest mark.

### **TRUST IN GLOCK**

- Perhaps one of the most undervalued players in the country, Devin McGlockton simply helps the Dores win. It's not the flashiest basketball, but the veteran was an integral part of the NCAA Tournament squad.
- McGlockton is set to return to his more natural role as a four on the floor in 2025-26 after playing in the five spot all of last season.
- Even as an undersized five, McGlockton averaged 10.3 ppg and 7.9 reb last season. He ranked seventh in the SEC in total rebounding while finishing third with 3.12 offensive boards per game.
- The ever consistent McGlockton record 19 doublefigure scoring games and 11 games with double digit rebounds.




