## QUICK HITS

- WKU is in its **107th season** of men's basketball and has **1,915 program wins** — the **18th-most of all Division I men's basketball programs**.
- Hank Plona is in his **second season** at the helm in Bowling Green and owns a **21-15 overall record** as WKU's head coach.
- The Hilltoppers are **4-0** in 2025-26 with wins against Tennessee Tech, Eastern Kentucky, Tennessee State and Bethel (Tenn.). It's their **first 4-0 start** since the 2019-20 campaign.
- WKU ranks **seventh nationally** in turnovers per game (7.7) and 13th in turnover margin (+8.0).
- Teagan Moore** has sparked WKU's 4-0 start, averaging a team-high 18.2 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, posting 15 points or more in all four games.
- Armelo Boone** has earned **back-to-back CUSA Freshman of the Week** selections after averaging 12.3 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.7 steals over the last three games. He leads CUSA in total steals (12) and steals per game (3.0).
- After missing two seasons, **Terrion Murdix** is averaging 8.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals in 22.0 minutes through four games. WKU has outscored opponents by 72 when he's on the floor.

## THE JUMP BALL

### ABOUT THE TOPS

- WKU improved to 4-0 on the season with a decisive 97-67 victory over Bethel (Tenn.), powered by a balanced offensive attack, strong outside shooting and a disruptive defense. Grant Newell led the way with 16 points, while Teagan Moore and Kade Unsel added 15 apiece, including a first-half surge from Unsel, who buried four straight 3-pointers. Four Hilltoppers finished in double figures as WKU knocked down a season-high 12 threes and 31 free throws, holding Bethel to 33.3% shooting and leading nearly wire to wire.
- WKU has been one of the most aggressive teams in the country at getting to the foul line, ranking fourth nationally with 34.0 free throw attempts per game, while sitting sixth in free throws made at 25.0 per contest. The Hilltoppers have attempted at least 28 free throws in every game, hitting 23 or more in three of four outings. Their 31-of-41 performance against Bethel marked the program's most free throws made and attempted in a game since going 36-of-45 in an 88-74 win over Tennessee State on Dec. 1, 2018.
- Defensively, WKU has been among the nation's most disruptive units, ranking 22nd nationally with 11.0 steals per game. The Hilltopper backcourt is anchored by freshman guard Armelo Boone and junior guard LJ Hackman, who both rank in the top five in Conference USA in total steals, with Boone tied for the league lead at 12 and Hackman fourth with 10. Through the first four games, WKU also stands among the national leaders in taking care of the ball, ranking 18th with just 9.0 turnovers per game and 11th in turnover margin at plus-7.2. The Hilltoppers have won the turnover battle in every contest, posting advantages of 19-11 against Tennessee Tech, 14-3 at Eastern Kentucky, 14-9 versus Tennessee State and 18-13 against Bethel.
- Moore has been a major catalyst in WKU's 4-0 start, averaging a team-best 18.2 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. He has scored at least 15 points in every outing and matched his career high with 22 points at Eastern Kentucky. WKU owns a plus-69 margin with him on the floor. Moore missed all of last season due to injury following a Conference USA All-Freshman Team campaign in 2023-24.
- Boone has earned Conference USA Freshman of the Week honors in back-to-back weeks, helping WKU to its 4-0 start with 12 points on 5-of-11 shooting, four steals, three rebounds and an assist in 15 impactful minutes off the bench against Bethel. The Hilltoppers were plus-9 with him on the court. For the season, he is averaging 9.8 points on 43.6% shooting along with 4.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists and a CUSA-best 3.0 steals per game, totaling 12 steals and recording at least three steals in three of four contests. His four-steal performance in the season opener against Tennessee Tech made him the first WKU freshman with four or more steals in a collegiate debut.
- After missing the last two seasons due to injury, veteran guard Terrion Murdix has provided steady production with 8.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals in 22.0 minutes per game. He has converted 40.0% of his field goal attempts (10-of-25) and 77.8% at the line (14-of-18). WKU has outscored opponents by 72 points when he has been on the floor.
- Senior forward Grant Newell has been a consistent scoring option for the Hilltoppers, averaging 14.8 points on 48.6% shooting. He is 18-of-37 from the field, has connected on a team-high six 3-pointers and is 17-of-21 (81.0%) at the free-throw line.

### QUOTABLE

- "Obviously, it's the next week for us, it's the next couple games, but obviously, it's the highlight to our nonconference schedule, going to Battle 4 Atlantis and being in an eight-team field with seven top 100 teams in the country. It's a heck of an opportunity for us to play some of the best teams and to see where we currently stack up. Obviously, spending the next five days getting prepared for Vanderbilt, but also trying to make sure we improve as a team and figure out how to be prepared for three games in three days. Looking forward to what's in front of us. I know the guys are and we'll go down there and see what we can do." — Mahurin Family Foundation Head Coach Hank Plona, ahead of Battle 4 Atlantis.

### SERIES INFORMATION

- Wednesday will mark the 26th meeting between WKU and #23/24 Vanderbilt. It's the first matchup between the Hilltoppers and Commodores since 2010.
- Vanderbilt leads the all-time series, 14-11. WKU's last win in the series came on Dec. 1, 2009, when the Hilltoppers defeated the #24 Commodores, 76-69, inside the Sommet Center in Nashville, Tenn.

### SCOUTING THE COMMODORES

- #23/24 Vanderbilt enters Wednesday's game with a perfect 5-0 overall record. The Commodores have scored in triple digits in four of their five games this season.
- Vanderbilt is led by Mark Byington, who is in his second year as the coach of the Commodores and 14th season overall as a head coach. He owns a 244-146 career record.

## HILLTOPPERS CRUISE TO 97-67 WIN BETHEL (TENN.), MOVE TO 4-0

**BOWLING GREEN, Ky.** — WKU Hilltopper Basketball moved to 4-0 with a 97-67 win over Bethel (Tenn.) on Tuesday night inside E.A. Diddle Arena.

WKU used balanced scoring, hot outside shooting and tough defense for a commanding win over Bethel, remaining unbeaten on the year behind strong performances from Grant Newell, Teagan Moore and a breakout first-half stretch from Kade Unseld.

### HOW IT HAPPENED

- WKU went nearly four minutes without a field goal before Grant Newell hit a 3-pointer to give the Hilltoppers a 7-6 lead at the first media timeout. The Hilltoppers first four points came from free throws.
- After Bethel tied it at 7-7 with a free throw, the Hilltoppers outscored the Wildcats 8-0 — capped by a Teagan Moore and-one off a steal — to take a 15-7 advantage with 12:08 in the half.
- Kade Unseld got hot at the 10-minute mark, draining four consecutive 3-pointers in just two minutes to push WKU's lead to 31-16 with eight minutes remaining.
- The Hilltoppers extended the margin to 22 after a Jack Edelen 3-pointer, but Bethel closed the half with a 4-0 run to trail 44-26 at halftime.
- Grant Newell scored WKU's first 10 points of the second half with two 3-pointers, two free throws and a layup, stretching the Hilltopper lead to 54-30.
- Teagan Moore scored six points during an 8-0 run that pushed the lead to 26. Bethel trimmed the lead to 66-44 with back-to-back 3s.
- Ryan Myers converted a four-point play to keep WKU comfortably ahead before an Unseld layup, four free throws and a Cam Haffner 3-pointer increased the gap to 85-61 with just over three minutes left.
- The Hilltoppers finished on an 8-0 run, with Cade Stinnett scoring six — including an and-one and a 3-pointer — for a 97-67 win.

### NOTABLES

- WKU improves to 4-0 on the season and 2-0 all-time against Bethel (Tenn.), its best start since 2019-20.
- The starting was Terrion Murdix, LJ Hackman, Teagan Moore, Grant Newell and Blaise Keita.
- Announced attendance was 2,523.
- Four players scored in double figures. Grant Newell paced the offense with 16 points, matching his season-high. Teagan Moore and Kade Unseld had 15 each and Armelo Boone chipped in 12.
- Newell was efficient on 4-of-6 shooting, 3-of-4 from 3-point range and 5-of-6 at the line in 16 minutes.
- Unseld made his first collegiate baskets, scoring 12 points on four straight 3-pointers in two first-half minutes, finishing 5-of-8 from the floor and 4-of-7 from long range. WKU was plus-26 with him on the court in the game.
- Moore was a perfect 9-of-9 from the line, adding a career-high five assists, four rebounds, a steal and a block over 25 minutes. He's scored 15-plus points in all four games.
- Boone posted double-digit points for the third straight game and notched four steals, leading Conference USA with 12 total steals.
- Terrion Murdix grabbed a team-high eight rebounds and chipped in three points and three assists.
- LJ Hackman added four steals and seven points in 13 minutes, hitting 5-of-8 at the stripe.

- Cam Haffner hit a pair of triples and grabbed three rebounds in 12 minutes.
- Cade Stinnett logged six points on a perfect shooting night, including a made 3-pointer.
- WKU shot 42.9% overall, held Bethel to 33.3% and knocked down a season-high 12 treys at 44.4%.
- The Hilltoppers also hit a season-high 31-of-41 free throws.
- WKU led in points off turnovers (28-10), points in the paint (33-20), fast-break points (18-12) and bench points (56-37), leading for nearly 37 minutes and trailing for only eight seconds.

### QUOTABLES

- "Obviously, trying to use tonight to keep moving in the right direction, keep getting better and get a win while we're at it. We got a win while we were at it, so that was good. It's crazy with these games. The general noise is, 'Well, why are you playing this game?' Or, 'These guys aren't any good,' and I just think it's so disrespectful to an opponent and I just think it's really hard to shield players from hearing that. Honestly, we were fighting our own human nature all week. I would even say leading up to Tennessee State. I've mentioned it a few times, but I feel like if we're not playing Kentucky or Louisville there's, 'Well, why are we playing these guys?' To me, it's just massively disrespectful to our opponent. I think we were trying to focus on ourselves and our preparation. It shouldn't matter if it's Tennessee State, Bethel, Vanderbilt, VCU, South Florida, the Lakers, the Knicks or the Purples. We need to focus on doing our best." — Mahurin Family Foundation Head Coach Hank Plona, on the win over Bethel (Tenn.).
- "Yeah, just staying ready. Being patient. Controlling what I can control. The last game I came in and airballed three feet over the rim. Just trying to relax, get the rust off. I haven't played in a year. Once the first one goes in, the rim looks like the ocean." — Guard Kade Unseld, on his first collegiate points in the win over Bethel (Tenn.).
- "I felt like we were leaving a lot of points on the board early and I feel like we still did throughout the rest of the game. I felt like we could've played way better. If y'all thought the offense was flying, we have a lot more of that, that we can show. I felt like we gave a lot of second chance opportunities, so I felt like the offense could've looked a lot better if we could've taken care of things on the defensive end." — Forward Grant Newell, on the win over Bethel (Tenn.).

Hank Plona was named the 17th head men's basketball coach at WKU, Director of Athletics Todd Stewart announced on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. Plona came to The Hill as an assistant in 2023. Prior to WKU, Plona was the head coach at Indian Hills (Iowa) Community College.

In Plona's first year as head coach, the team excelled on its home court, going 12-4 at Diddle Arena, even while dealing with injuries to key starters and reserves. Plona's leadership also helped him become a finalist for the prestigious Joe B. Hall Award, presented annually to the top first-time Division I head coach. His debut season continued WKU's momentum after their 2024 NCAA Tournament appearance.

As an assistant coach at WKU during the 2023-24 season, Plona was integral in the Hilltoppers returning to the NCAA Tournament for the first since 2013. The Tops led the country in adjusted tempo (75.2 possessions per game, per KenPom) and averaged 80.2 points per game, their most since the 1994-95 season (80.4 ppg) and best in

Conference USA. Overall, WKU went 22-12 and won the Conference USA Tournament as the league's No. 3 seed.

One of Plona's All-American stars from Indian Hills, Don McHenry, was named All-CUSA, first team All-District, and CUSA Tournament MVP. The Milwaukee, Wisconsin native started 66 games for the Hilltoppers from 2023-25, averaging a team-best 16.0 points per game. He also led the Hilltoppers with 136 assists, shooting 42.7% from the field, 33.0% from three and 83.7% from the free throw line. Plona also coached Enoch Kalambay at Indian Hills. Kalambay played in 62 games for WKU from 2023-25, starting 22, while averaging 7.1 points per game and 4.4 rebounds per game in 19.7 minutes per game.

Depth was a hallmark of WKU's success during the 2023-24 season, as the Hilltoppers were 17th nationally in bench scoring at 28.8 points per game. Eight players averaged at least 18 minutes per game and six Hilltoppers averaged over 8 ppg.

In eight seasons as a head coach at Indian Hills, Plona won 86.5% of his games and led Indian Hills to eight consecutive ICCAC regular-season titles, six postseason conference titles and the NJCAA National Tournament seven times.

Over those eight seasons, Plona coached the Warriors to a 225-35 (.865) record. IHCC qualified for the NJCAA National Tournament in seven of those eight seasons. Plona led the team to eight consecutive ICCAC regular-season titles, six postseason conference titles and four district championships.

In his last season, Plona led Indian Hills to a semifinal run at the 2023 NJCAA National Tournament, the team's best finish since 2014. They were ranked No. 1 in six different polls during Plona's tenure and ranked in the national rankings all but one week, including 39 Top-10 rankings and 18 Top-five rankings over his last four seasons alone.

Plona coached 12 All-Americans in his time at IHCC, along with 42 All-Region performers. A total of 59 of his players moved on from IHCC to Division I schools, and nearly 20 of those former Warriors are currently playing professionally around the globe. One hundred twenty-three student-athletes garnered Iowa Community College Athletic

Conference (ICCAC) All-Academic honors for their work in the classroom. As a team, the Warriors were named an NJCAA Academic Team of the Year during the 2021-22 campaign.

Plona was named the ICCAC Coach of the Year on four separate occasions while earning five NJCAA District Coach of the Year honors. Under Plona's tutelage, six consecutive Indian Hills Men's Basketball players were named ICCAC DI Men's Basketball Players of the Year. Along with the success of moving players on to the next level, Plona has seen an abundance of former assistant coaches earn spots at high-level programs throughout the country.

Notably, Tomas Woldetensae landed with 2019 National Champion Virginia, while the following season, Tyon Grant-Foster was sought out by Bill Self and the Kansas Jayhawks. Recent seasons also saw three former IHCC players join Power Five schools in Maurice Calloo (Oregon State), Chris Payton (Pittsburgh) and J'Vonne Hadley (Colorado).

Prior to his first head coaching job, Plona was an assistant coach at South Plains College in Levelland, Texas for four seasons. The team made three national tournament appearances in Plona's four seasons there, winning the national title in 2012 with an undefeated record. His team also made it to the championship game in 2015, just prior to Plona being named head coach at Indian Hills.

Plona spent one season as an assistant coach at IHCC (2010-11) and one as an assistant coach at Arkansas Fort-Smith (2009-10).

The Avon, Connecticut native was a student manager and graduate assistant at Providence College under Tim Welsh and Keno Davis.
