THE GIST

Ingram is Impressive

Stefanie Ingram has recorded at least three assists in all 10 games this season. That is tied for the second-longest streak to begin a campaign by any USF player this century (Shantia Grace in 2005-06) behind Elisa Pinzan's 21-game stretch to begin 2020-21. She has accounted for 41.7 percent of the team's assists this season, the highest share in the American and 13th highest among all DI players. The last USF player to finish a season with a higher share of the category was Elisa Pinzan in 2020-21 (43.2%). Ingram is one of eight DI players this season who have at least 60 assists and 10 made threes. The only other USF players this century to reach those marks through 10 games of a season are Elisa Pinzan (2020-21, 2021-22), Laia Flores (2017-18), and Shantia Grace (2005-06).

Fatou off the Bench

Fatou Diakite came off the bench in her last game and recorded 12 points, seven rebounds, two steals, three blocks, and zero turnovers. The only other USF reserve since 2000-01 to reach those marks in a game was Dulcy Fankam Mendjiadeu (Nov. 22, 2021).

L'or is a Rebounding Machine

L'or Mputu is one of seven DI players since the beginning of last season to have at least 1,000 minutes played, 8.0 rebounds per game, and a 58.0 field-goal percentage. She has at least one offensive rebound and one made field goal in 33 straight games, the third-longest active streak among all Division I players. The only USF player with a longer streak this century was Courtney Williams, who had a 37-game run (2013-14 and 2014-15).

Katie's Impressive Start

Katie Davidson is the third USF player this century to have at least 100 points and 11 or fewer turnovers through their first 10 career games with the Bulls, joining Tamara Taylor (2013) and Janae Stokes (2008).

Making it Count at the Line

South Florida has shot at least 75.0 percent from the free-throw line in eight straight games, the second-longest active streak in DI (Penn – eight). That is the longest streak for USF this century.

The Bulls have made at least 10 free throws in 13 straight games dating back to last season, tied for the fifth-longest active streak in DI. That is the longest run for USF since a 16-game stretch between November 2014 and January 2015.

Experienced Squad

USF's active roster has played in a combined 829 games at the Division I level. That is the most among all American Conference teams and ninth in Division I. South Florida has had 89.8 percent of its assists this season come from upperclassmen. That is the second-highest share in the American (Wichita State – 100.0) and 29th in DI.

Scoring 90

South Florida is a perfect 46-0 since 2000-01 when scoring at least 90 points. The Bulls are one of 11 DI teams with at least 45 wins without a loss in such games over that period.

Michele Woods-Baxter, or Coach B, was named interim head coach effective Oct. 23, 2025, and enters her 18th season on the South Florida coaching staff during the 2025–26 campaign. Woods-Baxter joined the Bulls in August 2008 as an assistant coach, was elevated to associate head coach in May 2018, and has been instrumental in leading South Florida to nine 20-win seasons, 13 postseason appearances, and eight NCAA Tournament berths.

Woods-Baxter works primarily with South Florida's wing players and plays a vital role in the overall development of the Bulls' roster. Over the past decade, she has mentored several of the program's top performers, including USF's first All-American, Courtney Williams, along with All-America honorees Kitija Laksa and Maria Jespersen.

During the record-setting 2020–21 campaign, Woods-Baxter's influence was evident as the Bulls captured their first-ever American Athletic Conference regular-season and tournament championships and climbed to a program-best No. 12 in the AP Poll. Three of the five players earning All-Conference recognition were wings under her guidance—Elena Tsineke (First Team), Sydni Harvey (Third Team), and Maria Alvarez (Co-Sixth Player of the Year). Harvey was also named AAC Tournament Most Outstanding Player, joining Tsineke on the all-tournament team.

In 2021–22, Woods-Baxter continued to develop Tsineke, who earned First Team All-AAC honors, was named to The American All-Tournament Team, and appeared on the Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award Watch List, recognizing the nation's top shooting guards.

Renowned for her international recruiting acumen, Woods-Baxter has been at the forefront of USF's global recruiting efforts, helping the program attract seven five-star international standouts since 2014.

Since her arrival in 2008, the Bulls have earned 12 postseason bids in 14 seasons, highlighted by the 2009 WNIT Championship—defeating Kansas in historic Allen Fieldhouse—and consistent national prominence within The American.

Woods-Baxter has also coached All-Region wings Andrea Smith and Courtney Williams, both among South Florida's all-time scoring leaders. Williams led the AAC in scoring (20.3 ppg) in 2014–15, setting a single-season program record with 710 points, while Laksa flourished under Woods-Baxter's tutelage to become one of the most prolific shooters in USF history.

Before joining South Florida, Woods-Baxter spent eight years at Monmouth University, including three-and-a-half as head coach. She guided the Hawks to back-to-back winning seasons (2005–07) and consecutive NEC Tournament semifinal appearances. Her tenure produced seven straight winning seasons and seven top-four NEC finishes in eight years.

Woods-Baxter began her collegiate coaching career as associate head coach at Tallahassee Community College (1998–2000), where the Eagles went 50–19 and finished as state runners-up both seasons. She launched her coaching journey at St. Thomas Aquinas High School (1989–96) in Fort Lauderdale, Fla., as an assistant boys' coach, while also leading the Gold Coast Raiders AAU boys' program, where 20 of her players went on to play college basketball.

A native of Oxford, Mich., Woods-Baxter earned her bachelor's degree in communications from St. John Fisher College in Rochester, N.Y., where she was a member of the volleyball team. She resides in Tampa with her husband, Jim Baxter, former USF director of basketball operations.

MORE NOTABLES

Double-Doubles in November

Against Harvard, Kirsten Lewis-Williams became the third different USF player to have a double-double this season (L'or Mputu and Ines Piper). The last time the Bulls had three different players do that in a single November was in 2017 (Laura Ferreira, Maria Jespersen, and Shae Leverett).

Stellar Start

Edyn Battle and Katie Davidson are the first USF players this century to have at least 60 points and four or fewer turnovers through their first four career games with the Bulls.

Cleaning the Glass

This is the second time since 2000-01 that USF started a season with consecutive games having a +15 or larger rebound margin. South Florida did that in its first three contests of the 2018-19 season.

Edyn Being Edyn

Edyn Battle is the second USF player this century to have at least 40 points and three or fewer turnovers through her first two career games with the Bulls. The other was Sammie Puisis to start the 2022-23 season.

Garden of Edyn Battle

Edyn Battle is one of seven DI players to have at least 20.0 points per game and 30 steals in each of the last two seasons. The only USF players this century to reach those marks in a single campaign are Courtney Williams (2014-15, 2015-16) and Jessica Dickson (2005-06).

L'or at Her Best

L'or Mputu was one of five DI players in 2024-25 to have at least 250 rebounds, 25 steals, and a 60.0 field-goal percentage. She became the first USF player to reach those marks in a single campaign since Wanda Guyton (1987-88).

Carla Being Carla

With one more steal, Carla Brito will be the third USF player this century to have at least 100 steals, 650 rebounds, 150 assists, and 850 points in her USF career. The other two are Courtney Williams (2012-16) and Jessica Dickson (2003-07).

Experienced Bulls

The Bulls have the most experienced team in the American Conference in terms of combined games played. South Florida is eighth in the NCAA behind TCU (902), Minnesota (819), Texas Tech (812), SMU (800), Southern (756), Virginia (753), and UNLV (743).

Protecting the Rock and Dishing Out Assists

South Florida has led the American Conference in both the fewest turnovers per game and the highest assist-to-turnover ratio in each of the last two seasons. The Bulls are only one of five DI teams to lead their conference in both categories in 2023-24 and 2024-25 (Colorado State, FGCU, Green Bay, and Norfolk State).

Making it to the Big Dance

South Florida has made the NCAA Tournament eight times since the 2014-15 season, one of 22 D-I schools to do so over that span. All other current AAC programs have combined for seven total appearances over that same time frame.

South Florida comes into the 2025-26 campaign with a dominating 137-33 record at the Yuengling Center since the 2013-14 season ... In four of the last five seasons, the Green and Gold have only dropped two or fewer games at home.

The Yuengling Center has been one of the toughest places for visitors to play in since the beginning of the 2017-18 season. The Bulls are 55-4 in non-conference games, with a winning percentage of 93.1, the best in the American and tied for 15th in the NCAA.

South Florida has also proven to be one of the elite teams in the American Athletic Conference, and to do that you need to win games at home ... The Bulls are 56-21 in AAC games at home.

Games at the Yuengling Center are no vacation for nonconference foes when they come to Tampa ... Over the last 11 seasons, the Bulls have posted a 61-4 record in nonconference games at home...With the only losses coming to NC State, 66-54, in 2023-24, defending 2019 National Champion Baylor, 67-62, during the 2020-21 campaign, Louisville, 66-52, during the 2016-17 season, and St. John's, 55-52, during the 2014-15 season.

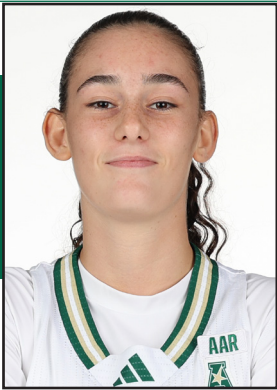

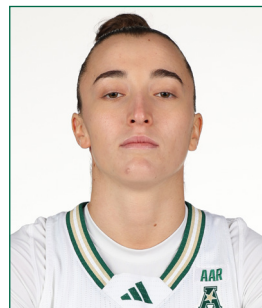
