CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:** Favour Nwaedozi had a career day in Mississippi State's victory over Samford on Sunday, as she collected her seventh double double of the season with a career-high 30 points on 66.7 percent shooting, along with 10 rebounds. Nwaedozi's performance marks the second 30-point performance this season for the Bulldogs and the 14th for the Southeastern Conference this season. She led the Bulldogs in scoring for the sixth time this season. Nwaedozi is one of five players in the Southeastern Conference to average a double double this season. Nwaedozi paced the Bulldogs to 112 points in the contest, which is the highest total in the Sam Purcell era and the most since November 18, 2019.

Florida's Me'Arah O'Neal led the Gators to their 12th win of the season Sunday, Dec. 28 with a 22-point, seven-rebound, four-assist, four-block, three-steal performance against Furman. Only five teams in program history have won more than 12 of their first 15 games, and no player in the country has reached all of those statistical marks in a single game this season (Opta StatsPass link). Only six players in the nation since the 1999-2000 season, including Candace Parker in 2006, have posted those figures in 34 minutes or less (O'Neal played 33 minutes and eight seconds).

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:** Jaylah Lampley made her first career start in Mississippi State's 112-54 victory over the Samford Bulldogs. Lampley finished the contest with her first double double, collecting season-highs of 24 points and 10 rebounds. Lampley's 24 points were the second most from a Mississippi State freshman this season. Lampley knocked down a season-high three three-pointers. She became the first Bulldog and second SEC freshman to shoot 100 percent from beyond the arch in a single game with at least three makes. Lampley has now knocked down multiple three-pointers in five games this season. Lampley's ten makes from the field marks her season best. Even though she attempted a season-high 12 field goals, Lampley still managed to stay efficient from the floor, shooting at an 83.3 clip.

Around the League

- The SEC and Big Ten lead all A4 conferences with four teams each that have at least seven wins over Division I opponents currently holding winning records.
- The SEC leads all A4 conferences with 36 non-conference wins over A4 opponents, well ahead of the Big Ten's 21.
- The SEC and Big Ten are tied atop the A4 conferences with nine non-conference wins over teams ranked in the AP Top 25 at the time of the game.
- The SEC and Big Ten are the only A4 conferences with a non-conference win over a team currently ranked in the AP Top 10; the Big 12 and ACC are a combined 0-17 in those matchups.
- Texas and South Carolina are two of only four teams nationwide with nine wins over Division I opponents that currently have winning records, along with UCLA and Connecticut.

SEC vs Everyone Else

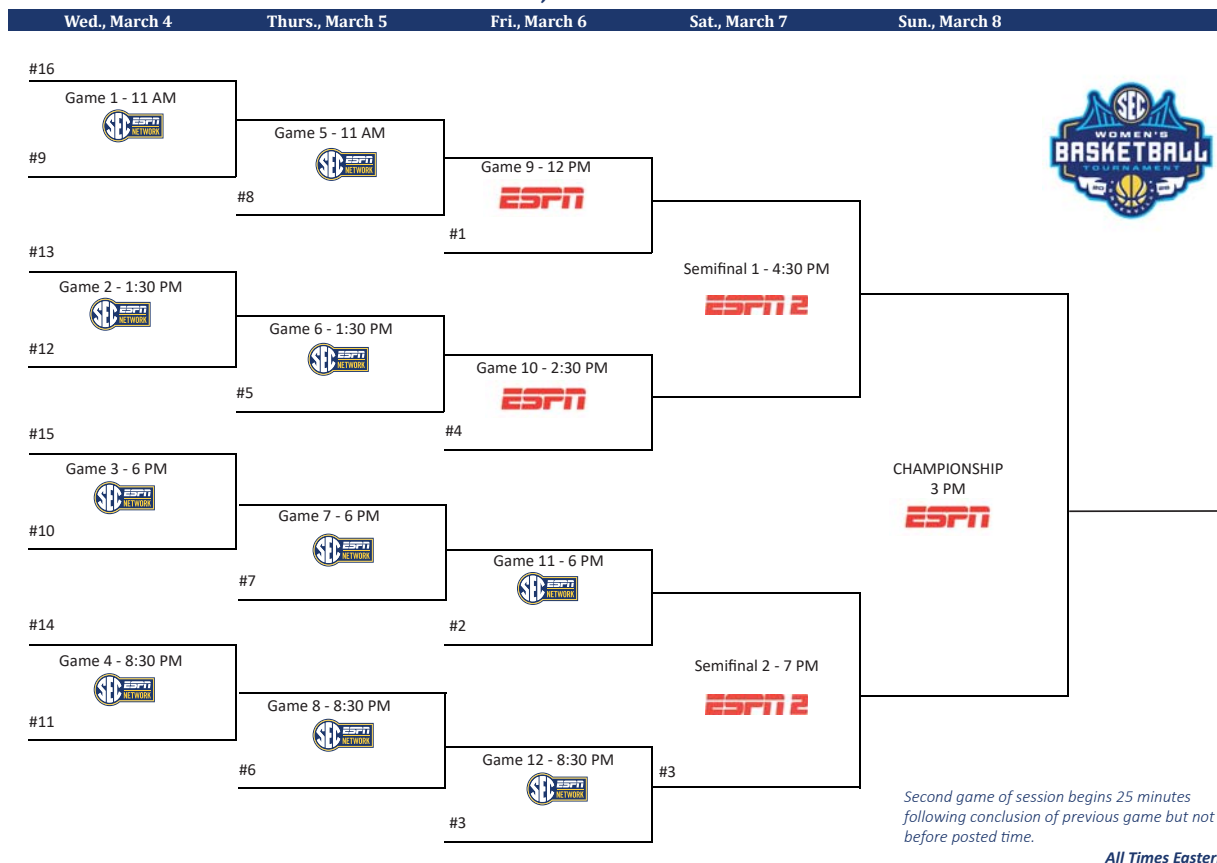
- The SEC has compiled a 194-23 (.894) non-conference record during the 2025-26 season.

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6370-1813 (.778) record against other conferences. In the post-season, SEC teams are 579-303 (.656) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6949-2115 (.767).

- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 31 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.

2026 SEC TOURNAMENT

2026 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament March 4-8 • Greenville, S.C. • Bon Secours Wellness Arena



SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
