CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Kentucky's Tonie Morgan had 24 pts, 12 assists, 0 turnovers and the game-winning, 3-point buzzer beater to defeat LSU. It marked Kentucky's highest-ranked road win in 52 years of program history. Then, despite the team's travel issues returning from Baton Rouge a day late and missing an entire day of practice Friday, she then followed that up with 18 points, 14 assists and just 3 turnovers in a home win against Missouri on Sunday. Her 24 points and 12 assists at LSU contributed to 66.2 percent of the team's scoring at LSU and her 18 points and 14 assists against Missouri contributed to 72.9 percent of the team's scoring against Missouri. Mikayla Blakes opened SEC play with back-to-back 30-point performances, as she averaged 33.5 points, 6.0 assists and 3.0 steals in a pair of wins at Arkansas and at home vs. No. 5/5 LSU. Blakes took over in the fourth quarter to help Vanderbilt collect the come-from-behind victory. She scored 15 of her game-high 32 points in the game's last stanza, shooting 55.6 percent in the frame (5-of-9) with a pair of 3-point field goals over the final 10 minutes. The guard registered 10 of Vanderbilt's final 13 points to close out the game. Blakes opened the week by matching her season high in scoring with 35 points at Arkansas in the 2026 SEC opener. The guard equaled her career-best in assists, as she dished out eight assists in the victory. Blakes also extends her double-digit scoring streak to 34 games, breaking a tie with assistant coach Ashley Earley for the second-longest streak by a Dore since 1999-00. She has recorded back-to-back 30-point games for the third time in her career, all of which have come against SEC teams.

• SEC CO-FRESHMEN OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Oklahoma's Aaliyah Chavez led the Sooners to a 2-0 start in SEC play last week, helping guide double-digit wins over Texas A&M and Mississippi State. The guard averaged 18.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists across the two victories. In her SEC debut on the road at Texas A&M, Chavez recorded her sixth 20-point game of the season, shooting 44 percent from the field while totaling seven rebounds, six assists and two steals. She is the only Power Five freshman to post that stat line this season and one of just two SEC freshmen to do so over the last five years. Chavez followed

with another strong performance against Mississippi State, scoring 18 points with six rebounds and three assists in a 95-47 win. Her seven games with at least 18 points lead all true freshmen in 2025-26.

Vanderbilt's Aubrey Galvan paced the Commodores to a 2-0 start in the first week of SEC play, as she averaged 14.0 points, 3.5 assists and 3.0 steals in a pair of wins at Arkansas and at home vs. LSU. Galvan came up big in her first career game against a ranked opponent, as she tallied 14 points and collected three steals in the 65-61 win over No. 5/5 LSU. The freshman hit the go-ahead 3-pointer with 2:05 remaining in the contest to give the Commodores their first win over a top-five team under Ralph. It is the first time since the 2008-09 season that Vanderbilt has defeated a team ranked inside the top five in both major college women's basketball polls. The last time it happened was on Feb. 19, 2009, when the Dores posted a 73-70 win over No. 3/3-ranked Auburn at Memorial Gym.

Around the League

- In the John R. Wooden Award Top 25 midseason list, the SEC has 14 players in consideration. That's more than all other conferences combined (Big Ten - 5, ACC - 2, Big East - 2, Big 12 - 2).
- The SEC leads all A4 conferences with 36 non-conference wins over A4 opponents, with the Big Ten next at 21.
- Texas, South Carolina and Vanderbilt are three of six teams nationwide that have at least 10 wins over D1 opponents that currently have winning records.

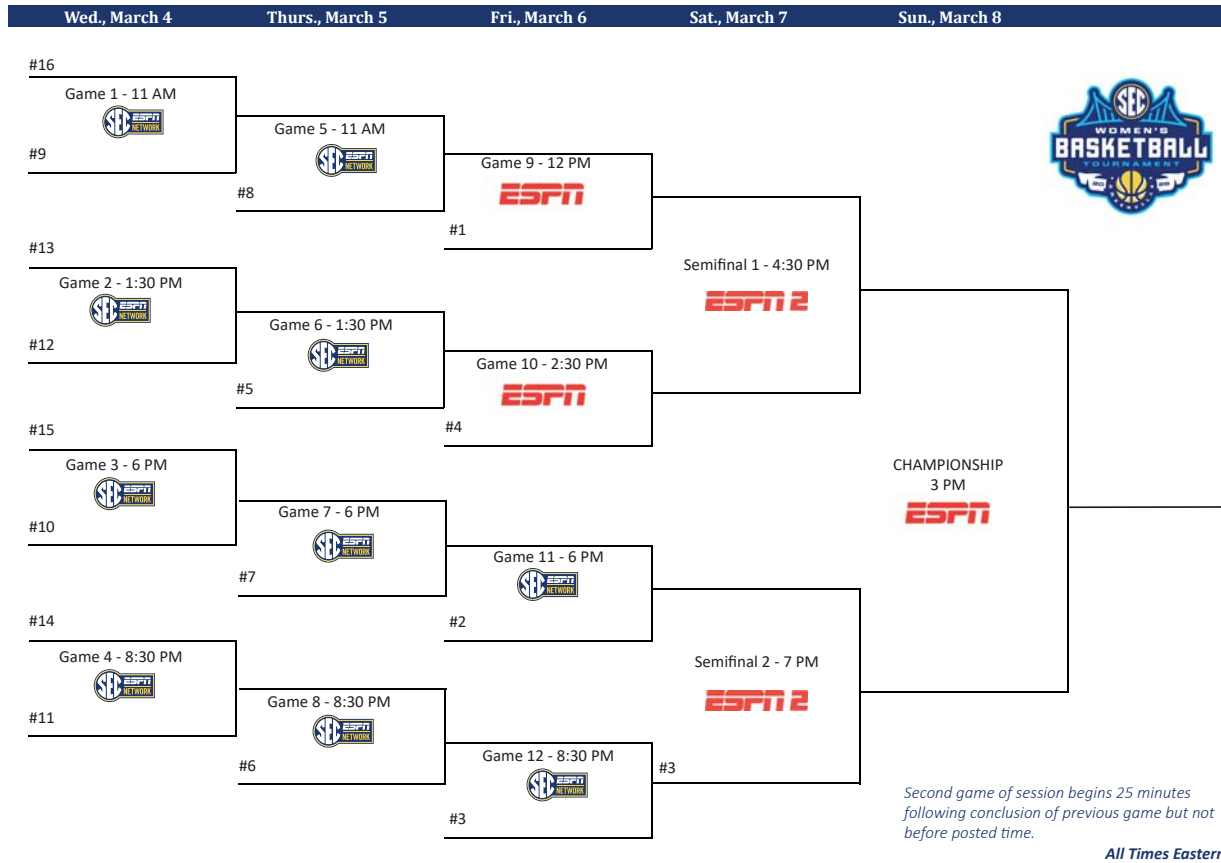
SEC vs Everyone Else

• The SEC has compiled a 194-23 (.894) non-conference record during the 2025-26 season.

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6370-1813 (.778) record against other conferences. In the post-season, SEC teams are 579-303 (.656) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6949-2115 (.767).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 31 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.

2026 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament March 4-8 • Greenville, S.C. • Bon Secours Wellness Arena



SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
