NUGGETS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Since head coach Nate Oats took over at The Capstone, Alabama has won a league-best 76 Southeastern Conference games and 156 games overall, which is ranked No. 1 for the most in the SEC during that span
- Alabama
- According to NCAA Stats, Alabama has had the third-toughest schedule among Power 4 schools with its opponents posting a .724 winning percentage, behind Texas Tech (.725) and Michigan (.714)
- Alabama is converting 13.2 three pointers per contest, which ranks No. 1 in the SEC and No. 2 in the country
- The Crimson Tide is averaging 6.6 blocks per game, which ranks No. 3 in Division I
- Aiden Sherrell ranks No. 7 in Division I in blocks per game, averaging 2.8 blocks per contest
- Last season, Alabama posted 67 blocks through 14 games and through the first 14 games of this season the Crimson Tide has recorded 93 blocks
- Alabama has had eight different starting lineups in its first 14 games of the season, the most lineup combinations under Oats during that span
- Alabama is the only team in the SEC that has two players rank in the top five in scoring in Labaron Philon Jr. (No. 2, 21.5 ppg) and Aden Holloway (No. 5, 18.4 ppg)
- With the Crimson Tide being ranked No. 13 in the AP Top 25 Poll, Alabama has now been ranked in 40 consecutive AP Top 25 Polls (began on 1/29/24)
- Oats has won a program-record 33 AP Top-25 games during his tenure at UA, surpassing Wimp Sanderson (25 games)
- For the fourth time under head coach Nate Oats, Alabama has won 10 games during its non-conference slate
- Alabama has scored 100 points or more in 103 games in program history, with Coach Oats' teams accounting for 34 percent of that number (35 games)

TUSCALOOSA, Ala. — The No. 14/15 Alabama men's basketball team picked up its first win of the new year with an 89-74 victory over the Kentucky Wildcats in the Southeastern Conference opener for both teams inside Coleman Coliseum.

The Crimson Tide had 43 combined points from its backcourt duo of Aden Holloway (26 points) and Labaron Philon Jr. (17) on Saturday afternoon. Holloway's 26 points tied a career-high for the second straight game this season.

The Tide had scoring from eight total players with three others in double figures, including Houston Mallette (14 points), Amari Allen (11 points) and Noah Williamson (10 points).

Kentucky was led by Otega Oweh's 22 points on 8-for-16 shooting from the floor to go along with eight rebounds and three assists.

Team Stats

- The victory marks Alabama's fourth straight win over Kentucky, the longest winning streak over the Wildcats in program history
- Nate Oats moved to a 7-4 record against Kentucky with a 4-1 record at home against the Wildcats
- Noah Williamson, who entered Saturday's contest with 14 total points this season, finished the day with a season-high 10 points to move him over 1,000 points in his career (1,007)
- The Tide won the rebound battle 41-37, with Amari Allen leading all players with nine boards, including six on the offensive glass
- Three-point shooting played a major factor in the contest, with Alabama finishing 15-for-38 (39 percent) from deep and Kentucky shooting just 4-for-19 (21 percent) from beyond the arc
- The contest saw just one lead change at the 16:16 mark in the first half, in which the Crimson Tide led the rest of the game

Head Coach Nate Oats Postgame Comments

"Great win to start off SEC play. Obviously, Kentucky has a great basketball tradition with a ton of talent on that team. Building a 21-point lead in the second half speaks to the way our guys started the game out. We started down 5-0 and then went on a big run. It's nice to change the starting lineup again with Houston Mallette. Houston is great, he's one of my favorite kids I've ever coached. He comes to me before games about keep bringing him off the bench. He started off 4-of-4 from three. He's just all about the right stuff. He's got a lot of Herb Jones in him, not caring where he starts. Our guards have been some of our better players and it's hard to put them all in there. We can put (Latrell) Wrightsell Jr. on their four man, so I thought that was big. You also can't do that without Amari Allen getting nine rebounds.

"We didn't expect Wrightsell to get a lot of rebounds guarding (UK's Mouhamed Dioubate), but he kept him off enough and guarded him well in the post. Dioubate is their second leading scorer coming into the game. We were trying to keep the ball out of the paint. Paint points were close, but they ended up outscoring us by four. The main thing was to keep the ball out of the paint and out of transition."

- Non-Conference Success:** For the first time under head coach Nate Oats and first time since the 2011-12 season, Alabama won 11 games during its non-conference schedule in 2024-25
 - Last season, Alabama's non-conference opponents posted a winning percentage of .701 last season, which ranked as the ninth-highest winning percentage in the country
 - The Crimson Tide's three AP Top-25 wins was tied for the most wins in non-conference play under head coach Nate Oats, matching the 2022-23 season

 - Alabama had a pair of players projected by the SEC and national media to make the All-SEC postseason teams, including Labaron Philon Jr. (All-SEC First Team) and Aden Holloway (All-SEC Third Team)
 - Labaron Philon Jr. was also named to the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Watch List for this season
- Tide Hoops in the NBA:** Alabama is well represented in the NBA this season as the Tide currently have nine players on NBA rosters
 - During the Oats era, Alabama has produced four NBA Draft first round picks (Noah Clowney, Brandon Miller, Joshua Primo and Kira Lewis Jr.)

When Nate Oats was formally introduced as head men's basketball coach at The University of Alabama on March 28, 2019, he promised fans would see an entertaining, up-tempo and fast-paced style of play. And that's exactly what he has delivered during his five years in Tuscaloosa highlighted by Alabama's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Final Four.

Oats continues to lead the Crimson Tide men's basketball resurgence to national prominence, having guided his team to 117 wins, highlighted by a pair of SEC Regular Season championships, two SEC Tournament championships, three trips to the Sweet 16 and the program's first ever appearance in the Final Four. Oats the only coach in program history to win multiple SEC regular season and tournament championships. He has compiled a record of 117-54 (.684) in his five years at The Capstone. In fact, in his nine years as a head coach, Oats owns an impressive record of 213-97 (.687) and has led his teams to NCAA Tournament appearances seven separate times with one of those years being the global pandemic.

After agreeing to contract extensions in 2021 and 2023, Oats received a third contract extension during the 2024 season that is set to keep him in charge of the Crimson Tide basketball program through the 2030 season.






