CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Dani Carnegie recorded the most points against a ranked opponent by any SEC player this week with career-high 32 points and career-best 11 rebounds in the 82-59 win against No. 16 Ole Miss. With her double-double performance, Carnegie became the first Georgia player since All-SEC center Jenna Staiti in 2021 to reach the 30-point mark, posting the highest point total for a Lady Bulldog in a single game since Gabby Connally in 2017 (nine seasons). The 32-point effort also marks the eight-best single-game total by an individual player in program history. Carnegie hit a career-high 65 percent from the floor, knocking in an impressive 11-of-17 shots. She also made a game-high five 3-pointers and hauled down 11 rebounds in the win. Carnegie posted her third double-double of the year and her fourth 20-plus point performance in the last five games. The Mount Vernon, NY leads the SEC with 56 made 3-pointers and a 43 percent effort from behind the arc for the year. She led Georgia to its largest margin of victory against a ranked opponent in 20 seasons (since 2005-06) as the Lady Bulldogs defeated Ole Miss by 23 points.

Mikayla Blakes averaged 26.0 points, 5.5 assists and 3.5 rebounds this past week to help Vanderbilt collect a pair of Quad 1 wins, while the Commodores extended the SEC's longest active winning streak to 19 games. The All-American opened the week by dropping a season-high 38 points at Mississippi State this past Thursday. Blakes made a season-best five 3-point field goals against the Bulldogs, while she dished out seven assists. She pulled down five rebounds in Starkville and went a perfect 11-of-11 from the free throw line. The Somerset, New Jersey, native made her return to the Garden State on Monday and guided the Dores to a 72-69 victory over No. 7/7-ranked Michigan at the 2026 Coretta Scott King Classic. Blakes battled foul trouble throughout her homecoming but was still able to register 14 points and four assists to help Vanderbilt pick up its second victory over a top-10 team this season. It is the first time since the 2008-09 season that Vanderbilt has collected multiple wins over teams ranked inside the top 10 of both of the major polls.

SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Vanderbilt freshman Aubrey Galvan averaged 14.0 points and 4.0 assists per game in a pair of Quad 1 wins last week to help Vanderbilt extend the longest winning streak in the SEC to 19 games. Galvan scored a career-high 20 points in the 72-69 victory over No. 7-ranked Michigan on Monday at the 2026 Coretta Scott King Classic. The guard shot 50 percent from the field, going 7-of-14, and sank three 3-pointers against the Wolverines, while she dished out three assists and had two steals. The freshman came in clutch down the stretch against the No. 7-ranked team, as her 3-pointer with three minutes left in the contest pushed Vandy's lead to seven points, and she hit a free throw with 2.5 seconds remaining to extend the Dores' lead to three. The 5-6 point guard dished out five assists and scored eight points in the 89-84 win at Mississippi State. Between points and assists, Galvan was responsible for 21 points at MSU.

SEC vs Everyone Else

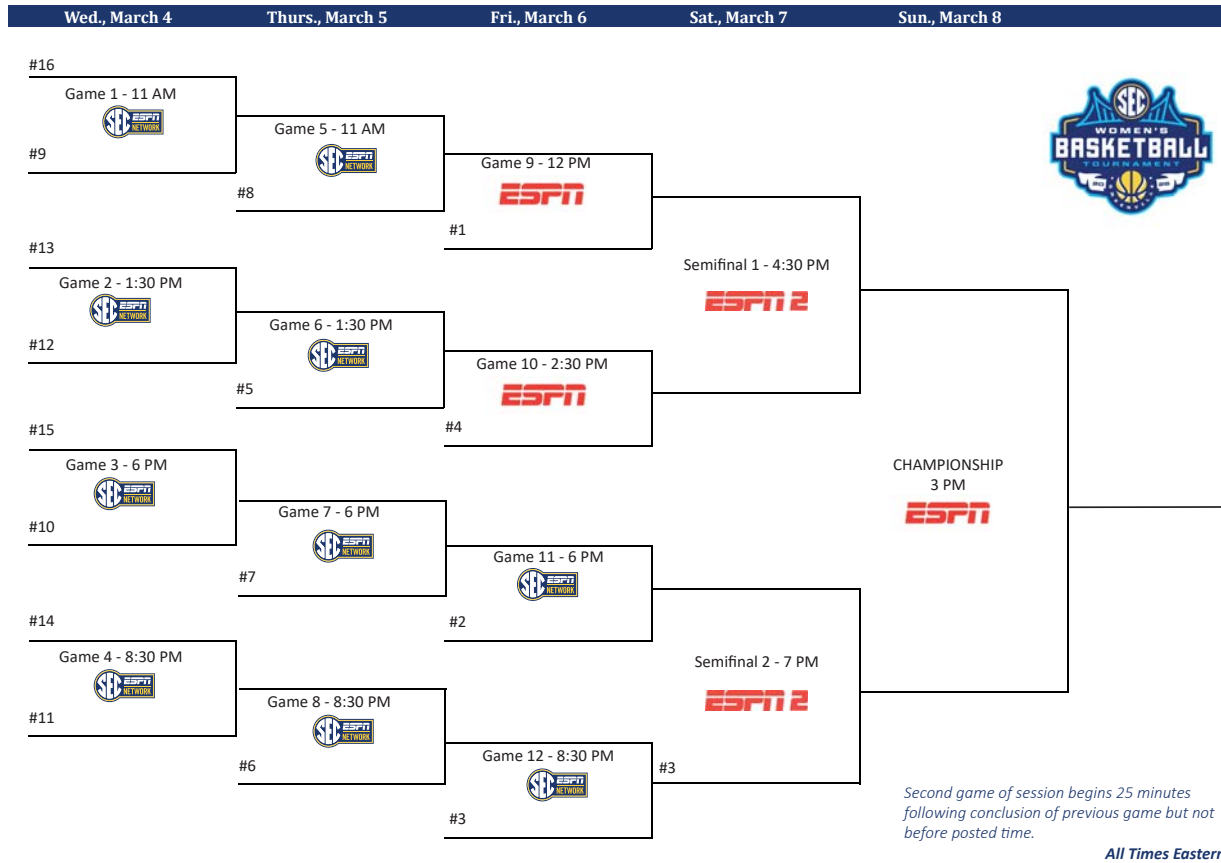
- The SEC has compiled a 196-23 (.895) non-conference record during the 2025-26 season.

- In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 6372-1813 (.778) record against other conferences. In the post-season, SEC teams are 579-303 (.656) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6951-2115 (.767).

- The league has recorded 150+ wins in 31 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.

2026 SEC TOURNAMENT

SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).

- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.
- The student-athletes who comprise the SEC Women's Basketball Leadership Council are: Jessica Timmons, Alabama; Jenna Lawrence, Arkansas; Ja'Mia Harris, Auburn; Laila Reynolds, Florida; Savannah Henderson, Georgia; Teonni Key, Kentucky; Izzy Besselman, LSU; Christeen Iwuala, Ole Miss; Chandler Prater, Mississippi State; Grace Slaughter, Missouri; Beatrice Culliton, Oklahoma; Maryam Dauda, South Carolina; Kaiya Wynn, Tennessee; Kyla Oldacre, Texas; Ny'Ceara Pryor, Texas A&M; Sacha Washington, Vanderbilt.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
