Weekly Honors

• SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

With 31 points in the win at Arkansas, Georgia's Dani Carnegie became the first Lady Bulldog since Katrina McClain in 1987 to post back-to-back 30-point efforts. She then led Georgia to an upset victory over No. 11-ranked Kentucky with a team and game high 19 points and a career-best eight assists. Against the Razorbacks on Thursday, Carnegie hit a career-high seven 3-pointers, tying the UGA record for the most 3-pointers made in a single game. She accounted for 41 percent of her team's scoring and added a team-high seven rebounds. Following a 48-hour turnaround, Georgia headed to Lexington in search of its second ranked win in less than a week. Carnegie delivered once again by leading all scorers with 19 points and dishing out a career high eight assists. The win marked the first time since 2011 that Georgia has defeated a pair of ranked teams within a week as the Lady Bulldogs won their third-straight game overall. Georgia is now 18-3 on the year – its best start since the 2017-18 season. Through seven SEC games, Carnegie is second in the league in scoring during SEC play with 23 ppg against conference foes. She also leads the league with 64 made 3-pointers this season.

Cotie McMahon had by far her most complete performance for the Rebels against Missouri, scoring a 33-point double-double, which ties her career high in points. She's the first Rebel to score 30 points this season, the first Rebel since Madison Scott to do so, and her point total is the most by a Rebel since Marquesha Davis had the same amount against Florida on March 8, 2024. She tied her season best in rebounds with 12, while also dropping five dimes and two blocks. On the season, McMahon has 11 games north of 20 points. Most of her offensive success came in the second half, scoring 24 of her points in quarters three and four. She went 9-for-13 from the field in the second half. She led the SEC and ranked fourth in the nation in points per game, while also ranking first in the conference in rebounds per game last week. Additionally, when McMahon is successful, her teammates are successful, as the four times she has secured a double-double this season, another Rebel has as well.

• SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Oklahoma freshman Aaliyah Chavez led Oklahoma to its highest-ranked win in program history and to a 2-0 week. The guard guided the Sooners to an overtime win over No. 2 South Carolina and a road victory at Auburn by averaging 22.0 points, 6.0 assists, 3.0 rebounds, while shooting 40% from the field at 47% from deep. In OU's win over the Gamecocks, Chavez finished with 26 points and a career-high eight assists. Fifteen of her 26 points came in the overtime period as the guard set a school record for points in an OT frame. She became the first freshman since Caitlin Clark in 2021 to post 26 points and eight assists against a top-25 opponent. Then in a road test at Auburn, Chavez scored 18 points, making four 3-pointers and dished out four assists to lead OU to a 72-65 win.

Around the League

- The SEC has 10 teams ranked with Georgia entering at No. 23. It's the first time in the 50-year history of the AP poll that a conference has 10 teams ranked.
- Seven teams nationwide have at least 13 wins against Division I opponents that currently have a winning record, three of which are from the SEC.

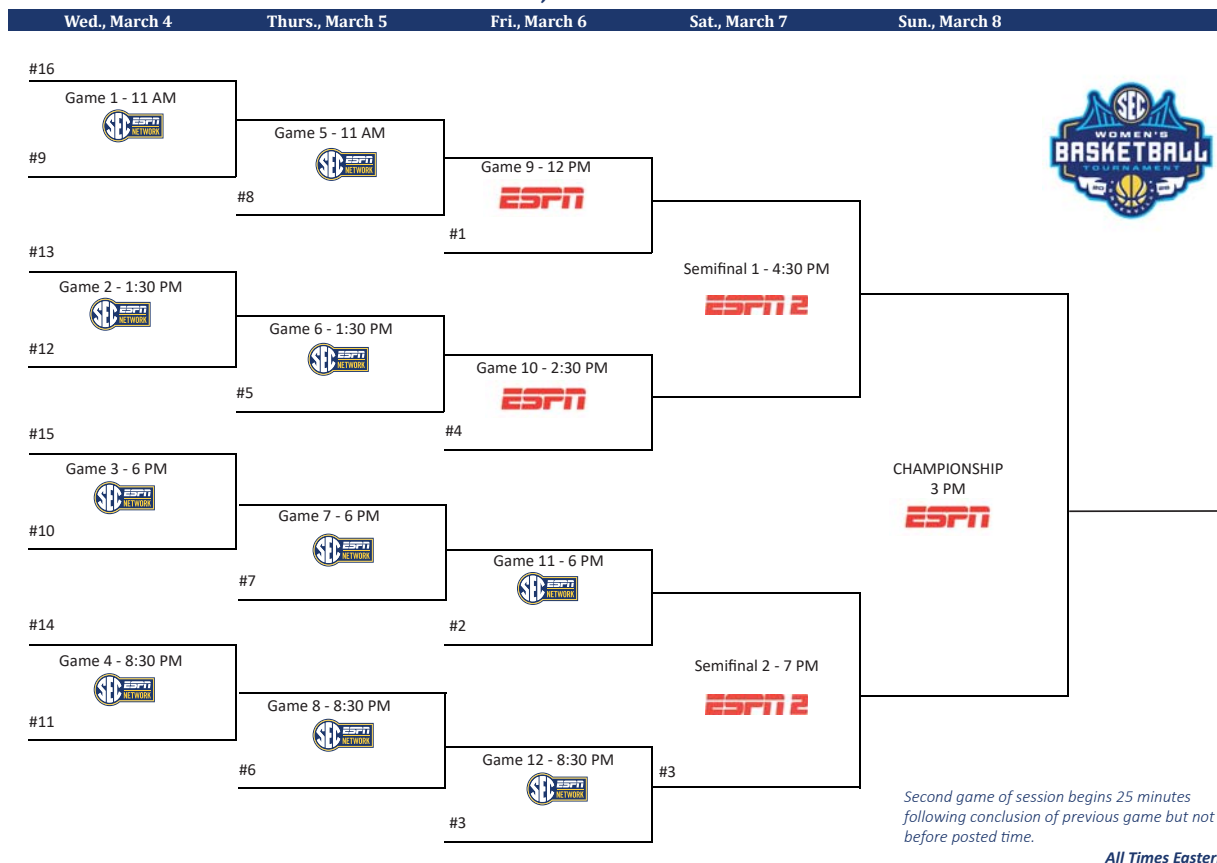

2026 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament March 4-8 • Greenville, S.C. • Bon Secours Wellness Arena



SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).

- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
