MEN'S 2025-26 BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

OPENING TIP

► Oklahoma (11-12, 1-9 SEC) looks for its third straight series win against Vanderbilt (19-3, 6-3) when it meets the No. 15/15 Commodores on Saturday at 2:30 p.m. CT at Memorial Gymnasium in Nashville, Tenn.

► Saturday's game will be televised by SEC Network with **Kevin Fitzgerald** (play-by-play) and **Mark Wise** (analyst) announcing. It will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXO 107.7 FM in Oklahoma City; KTBU 1430 AM in Tulsa; Varsity Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** on the call.

► Oklahoma is 3-8 away from home and 1-6 in true road games (lone true road win was at Wake Forest). In its five SEC road contests, OU is shooting 42% from the field and 31% (42 for 137) from 3-point range while opponents are shooting 46% and 34% (39 for 115). Vanderbilt is 11-1 at home on the season (4-1 in SEC play).

► Junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** has scored at least 13 points in 13 of the last 14 games, and has five outings of at least 20 points (23 vs. Ole Miss, 24 vs. Florida, 21 vs. Alabama, 22 at South Carolina, 21 at Kentucky). He is averaging 18.6 points a game over the last 14.

► **Nijel Pack**, a first-year Sooner who is in his sixth year overall (only played nine games last season at Miami), is one of just three active players with 2,000 career points (2,109; Gonzaga's Graham Ike has 2,338 and Indiana's Tucker DeVries has 2,301 through Wednesday). Over the last four games, Pack is averaging 19.0 points and has made 16 3-pointers on 33 attempts (48%). He ranks second in the SEC with his 3.2 3-pointers per contest.

► Oklahoma's 82.6 scoring average is its highest through a season's first 23 games since 2017-18 and fifth highest in the last 32 years. Similarly, OU's 9.7 3-pointers per game are its third most through 23 contests in the 40-year 3-point era.

► Oklahoma has committed single-digit turnovers 12 times, already its most such outings for an entire season in 11 years (12 times in 2014-15).

WEDNESDAY'S OU-KENTUCKY RECAP

► Oklahoma got a career-high-tying five 3-pointers and 21 points from **Xzavier Brown** and 16 points from **Tae Davis**, but gave up 12 3-pointers and were outrebounded by 16 in a 94-78 loss at Kentucky on Wednesday night inside Rupp Arena. UK (16-7, 7-3 SEC) shot 50% from the field to OU's 44% and posted a 19-7 advantage in second-chance points.

► Like they have in other recent games, the Sooners got off to a good start. They hit seven of their first 11 shots and took an 18-15 lead on a **Dayton Forsythe** 3-pointer with 12:38 left in the opening half. Davis was particularly effective early, scoring nine of the team's first 13. OU weathered a barrage of UK 3-pointers and trailed just 35-32 with 3:54 to go, but the Wildcats scored the last eight points of the half for a 43-32 lead.

► OU, which trailed by as many as 19 points in the second half at 57-38, was down 82-66 before assembling an 8-0 run to cut its deficit to eight points with 3:14 to go. Kentucky responded with an 8-0 run of its own, however, to seal its seventh win in its last eight outings.

► Brown was 6 for 11 from the field, 5 for 9 from behind the arc and made all four of his free throw attempts en route to his fifth 20-point effort in SEC play and 10th of the season. The junior added four assists, three rebounds and a pair of steals in a team-high 31 minutes.

► Davis was 7 for 11 from the floor and 2 for 3 from the charity stripe and added four assists to tie Brown for team-high honors, while **Derrion Reid** added 11 points with the help of 7-for-8 free throw shooting.

► Redshirt freshman forward **Kuol Atak**, who totaled one minute of action over OU's previous five games, played 16 minutes off the bench and tallied nine points — all in the second half — on 3-for-7 3-point shooting.

► Forsythe submitted his most productive outing since November, finishing with seven points in 21 minutes off the bench, but **Nijel Pack**, who averaged 23.3 points over the last three contests, was held to six points.

SCENE SETTERS

► Oklahoma has lost its last nine games but has held a halftime lead in four of the last six. In fact, it has held a double-digit first-half lead in three of the last six outings. In three of the last four contests, the Sooners have led with less than six minutes remaining, including with one second left in regulation and overtime at Missouri (the Tigers hit buzzer-beating 3-pointers in both instances) and with 22 seconds to go against Arkansas.

► OU is the only SEC team and one of just seven out of 361 nationally to start the same lineup every game this season. Its starters have been guards **Xzavier Brown** and **Nijel Pack**, forwards **Tae Davis** and **Derrion Reid** and center **Mohamed Wague**.

Vanderbilt has started four different lineups.

► Oklahoma has played three games inside Memorial Gymnasium in Nashville, but only one (in 1955-56) was against Vanderbilt. The other two were first- and second-round NCAA Tournament wins in 1989 as the Southeast Region's No. 1 seed over East Tennessee State (72-71; OU trailed by 15 in the second half) and Louisiana Tech (124-81). **Billy Tubbs'** Sooners featured first-team All-Americans **Stacey King** and **Mookie Blaylock**.

► Vanderbilt is in its second year under head coach **Mark Byington**, who is in his 13th year overall. The No. 15/15 Commodores are 19-3 on the year and 6-3 in the SEC. In their five league home games (4-1 record), they are outscoring opponents 85-77 per game and have limited them to 29% 3-point shooting. They also own a +4.8 average turnover margin in those contests (7.8-12.6), but have been outrebounded by an average of 3.6 per game.

► Vanderbilt guard **Duke Miles** started all 34 games for OU last season, averaging 9.4 points and shooting 51% from the field, 43% from behind the arc and 83% from the three point line. In 18 games this season (all starts), Miles is averaging 16.6 points

with respective shooting figures of 45%, 34% and 89%. He leads the Commodores with his 94 free throw makes and 106 attempts, and averages 4.3 assists and a league-high 2.8 steals per game.

SERIES HISTORY

► OU is 2-2 all-time against Vanderbilt, with both wins coming in Norman (86-55 under head coach **Lon Kruger** in 2018-19 in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge and 97-67 last season).

► Vanderbilt won the only meeting in Nashville, 78-69 in the 1955-56 season. The Commodores also won 77-67 in a first-round postseason NIT contest in Norman to end OU's 1993-94 campaign. It marked **Billy Tubbs'** final game as Sooners head coach.

LAST YEAR VS. THE COMMODORES

► Oklahoma trailed by as many as 13 points in the first half and by four at halftime, but sandwiched a 35-6 run around intermission and outscored No. 24 Vanderbilt 61-27 in the second half in a 97-67 home win on Feb. 1, 2025. It marked just the second time in program history the Sooners beat an AP-ranked team by at least 30 points.

► Freshman guard **Jeremiah Fears** finished with 21 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals, while senior forward **Jalon Moore** registered 19 points to pace the Sooners. Freshman guard **Dayton Forsythe** came off the bench to score a then-career-high-tying 14 points, while also contributing three rebounds, two assists and a career-high three steals. Ten of the 11 Sooners who attempted at least one field goal, including all five starters, shot 50% or better from the field.

► The game marked the first time since at least the 1996-97 season that OU scored 61 points in a half against a conference opponent. The Sooners outshot the Commodores 73% to 30% after halftime. After Vanderbilt scored the opening bucket of the

OU'S RICH HOOPS HISTORY

Oklahoma's storied men's basketball history is the envy of most SEC programs. The Sooners' five Final Four appearances are exceeded in the SEC by only Kentucky (17), Arkansas (6) and Florida (6). OU, which played in the 1947 and 1988 national title games, has participated in 34 NCAA Tournaments and has played in the postseason in 36 of the last 43 years.

Oklahoma has also generated 18 first-team All-Americans, including Hollis Price, Blake Griffin, Buddy Hield and Trae Young since the turn of the century. Griffin and Hield were consensus national players of the year. OU has produced two of the six Wooden Award winners from current SEC schools (Kentucky/Texas two each).

second half, OU went on a 23-0 run to take a 59-42 lead. Vandy trimmed the margin to 10 with 8:38 left, but the Sooners closed the game on a 30-10 run.

► OU, which didn't take its first lead until the 18:21 mark of the second half (44-42), shot 63% from the field, its best figure against a conference foe since the 2004-05 season. It entered the game ranked last in the SEC in rebounding margin in league play (-7.6), but posted a 39-24 advantage on the glass.

PACK MENTALITY

► First-year Oklahoma guard **Nijel Pack** surpassed the 2,000-point mark Jan. 11 at Texas A&M and has 2,109 for his career to rank third nationally among active players.
► Prior to Wednesday's game at Kentucky, Pack scored over 20 points in three straight games, matching his longest career streak (also in 2022-23 with Miami and 2021-22 with Kansas State).
► Pack ranks second in the SEC with his 3.2 treys per game and fourth with his .424 3FG percentage.
► Pack has made at least one 3-pointer in 21 of 23 games, at least three in 14 contests and at least four in 10 outings. He buried at least three treys in six consecutive games between Nov. 11 and Dec. 2, the first Sooner to accomplish the feat since consensus national player of the year **Buddy Hield** during OU's 2015-16 Final Four campaign.
► A sixth-year collegian, Pack spent his first two seasons at Kansas State (he was a first-team All-Big 12 pick as a sophomore when he averaged 17.4 points and made 95 3-pointers and shot a league-high .436 from behind the arc) and the last three at Miami, Fla. (he helped the Hurricanes to their first Final Four his junior season and was named the Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player). He has started 144 of his 145 career games.

OU's 'X' FACTOR

► Junior guard **Xzavier Brown** has scored at least 13 points in 13 of the last 14 games and at least 18 points in 10 of those 14 outings. He is averaging 18.6 in the 14 contests on 49% field goal, 41% (32-for-79) 3-point and 93% (52-for-56) free throw shooting. Included were five 20-point games in SEC play (23 in a win over Ole Miss, a season-high 24 against No. 19 Florida, 21 vs. No. 18 Alabama, 22 at South Carolina and 21 at Kentucky).
► Brown leads the SEC by shooting 92% from the free throw line (76 for 83). His streak of 27 makes ended Jan. 13 vs. Florida but he has made 54 of his last 58 attempts (93%).
► After scoring at least 20 points in 14 of 35 games last year at Saint Joseph's, Brown has a team-high 10 games of 20-plus in 23 outings this season (**Nijel Pack** ranks second with six such efforts). Brown has 30 career games of at least 20.

ELATONTSEV MAKING AN IMPACT

► OU announced Dec. 28 the signing of 23-year-old **Kirill Elatontsev** (pronounced kee-REEL EE-el-uh-tahn-suv), a 6-11, 240-pound center from Russia who is averaging 5.4 points and 2.9 rebounds in 16.5 minutes per contest over his 11 games. He is shooting 56% from the field, 42% (8 for 19) from 3-point range and 69% (11 for 16) from the free throw line. He has made at least one 3-pointer in five of the last seven games.

► On Jan. 13 vs. No. 19 Florida, Elatontsev scored 17 points on 4-for-4 field goal shooting (all 3-pointers) after totaling two points over OU's first three league games. Over the last seven contests he is averaging 7.3 points on 17-for-29 (59%) field goal and 8-for-18 (44%) 3-point shooting and has nine steals.


► Elatontsev most recently played for Lokomotiv Kuban in the VTB United League. In February 2024, he was called up to the Russian National Team.

MORE OU NOTES AND NUGGETS

► Oklahoma has led for at least 22 minutes in four of the last six games, all losses. It led for over 30 minutes Saturday against Texas.
► The Sooners have scored at least 85 points in 11 of their 23 games, already their most 85-point efforts in a season since 2017-18. For comparison, OU's last four teams scored 85-plus a combined 21 times in 133 games (16%; nine times last year, six in 2023-24, two in 2022-23 and four in 2021-22).
► OU's top four scorers are all transfers in their first year in the program. **Xzavier Brown** averages a team-high 16.4 points per game, while **Nijel Pack** (15.8), **Tae Davis** (12.7) and **Derrion Reid** (11.9) also average double figures. **Mohamed Wague** rounds out the starting five with his 6.3 per contest.
► Reid has scored at least 11 points in each of the last five games. He is averaging 12.6 points (53% field goal shooting) during the stretch.
► Wague (3.0) and Davis (2.5) rank third and eighth in the SEC in offensive rebounds per game. Davis had 11 offensive boards against Arkansas-Pine Bluff, OU's most in a contest since at least the 1995-96 season. He surpassed 1,000 career points and 500 rebounds this season (has 1,174 and 566).
► Davis went 41 for 66 (62%) from the free throw line over OU's first 17 games, but is 18 for 20 (90%) over the last six.
► Wague's three highest career point totals have come this season (16 in the opener vs. Saint Francis, 20 vs. Oral Roberts and 15 vs. Stetson), as have his two highest rebound totals (14 at Wake Forest and 15 vs. Ole Miss in the SEC opener).
► Long Beach State transfer **Jadon Jones** is averaging 5.4 points in 18.9 minutes per game over his 19 outings. He has also drawn 10 fouls while attempting a 3-pointer. The 2021-22 Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year has 10 steals and eight blocks over the past six games.
► Redshirt freshman forward **Kuol Atak** ranks third on the team with his 29 3-point makes (shooting 40%) despite averaging just 12.4 minutes over his 18 games. He is 19 for 39 (49%) from long distance in home contests, including 10 for 19 (53%) over his last three outings at Lloyd Noble Center. Prior to Wednesday's contest at Kentucky in which he scored nine points on 3-for-7 3-point shooting in 16 minutes, he had played in just one of the last five games (one minute at South Carolina).
► Nine of the 15 players on OU's roster are new in 2025-26, and three more were on last year's team but redshirted.

HEAD COACH PORTER MOSER

SIX POSTSEASON APPEARANCES ■ 2018 NCAA FINAL FOUR ■ 2021 NCAA SWEET 16 ■ 12 ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser is in his fifth season leading the Sooners in 2025-26. Moser was hired on April 3, 2021, becoming the 15th head coach in program history after a stellar 10-year run as head coach at Loyola Chicago that included NCAA Final Four and Sweet 16 appearances.

The 2024-25 season was Moser's most successful at OU, guiding his team to a 20-14 record and a No. 9 NCAA Tournament seed. The Sooners, who won their first 13 games and climbed to as high as No. 10 in the Coaches poll and No. 12 in the AP version, played one of the nation's toughest schedules, with 14 games against AP top-25 opponents and 22 of 34 contests against teams that made the NCAA Tournament. OU went 3-0 to win the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas in November before navigating its first season in the rugged Southeastern Conference, a league that placed a record 14 teams in the NCAA Tournament. The Sooners also set a program record with their .795 free throw percentage, obliterating the previous mark of .767 by the 2001-02 Final Four team.

Point guard Jeremiah Fears was named to the 2024-25 SEC All-Freshman Team and was selected No. 7 overall in the 2025 NBA Draft by the New Orleans Pelicans to become Moser's highest draft pick. Fears was one of just three Power Four conference players (the only one in the SEC and the only freshman) to average at least 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals per contest.

In 2023-24, Moser guided OU to a 20-12 mark, ranking as high as seventh in the AP poll. The Sooners reached 20 regular season wins for the first time since 2015-16 and began the season 10-0, tying the 1991-92 and 2003-04 seasons for the seventh-best start in program history. OU bested Iowa and USC at the Rady Children's Invitational, claiming its second consecutive midseason tournament title, and Javian McCollum and Jalon Moore earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sherfield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

In 2021-22, Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition. Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament, earning an opening-round victory over Missouri State at Lloyd Noble Center.

Umoja Gibson, Jordan Goldwire, Groves and Elijah Harkless earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors, and C.J. Noland earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was tabbed a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Before his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021.

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the 2017 CBI title and qualifying for the 2019 NIT. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mention All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins. He guided the 2017-18 squad to a school record 32 victories and an appearance in the Final Four – Loyola's first appearance since winning the 1963 NCAA Championship.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed to advance to the Final Four, beating Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Coach of the Year and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 team ranked second nationally in personal fouls per game (just 13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer was named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-America honors, becoming the first play in Loyola history to receive both in the same season.

Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his fourth year working with the Sooners and second as an assistant coach in 2024-25 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola (2020-21), Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles. As an eighth seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 359-287 (.556) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season before his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories before his tenure. Moser turned the program around in one season, finishing with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011. He returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach before the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, a former OU's women's basketball player, Jake, a former OU men's player, and Max and Ben.
