CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate:
Sophomore forward Joyce Edwards paced the Gamecocks to a pair of wins that put South Carolina atop the SEC regular-season standings. The team's 43-point win over No. 19/17 Tennessee marked the highest margin of victory against a ranked opponent in Gamecock history. In a win over Mississippi State, Edwards scored nine of the team's first 15 points en route to a 10-point lead after the first quarter. She finished the night with a career-high tying six assists and 21 points, which made her the fifth-fastest Gamecock to reach the 1,000-point plateau as she hit the mark in her 64th career game. In the commanding win over Tennessee, the largest in Lady Vols' history, Edwards' 20 points included four straight late in the first quarter to turn a tie game into a seven-point Gamecock lead at the end of the period. Her scoring was steady throughout the game to finish with 20 points, marking her fourth-straight SEC game hitting that mark, which is the longest such streak by a Gamecock in program history. The four-game stretch of games regardless of opponent is the longest since A'ja Wilson put together five 20-point games Dec. 5, 2017, through Jan. 4, 2018.

Mikayla Blakes had back-to-back 30-point performances against a pair of top-25 teams, as the sophomore averaged 35.5 points, 5.0 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game to help Vanderbilt go 2-0 last week. The sophomore opened her week with a 37-point effort at No. 16/16 Kentucky to help the Dores collect an 84-83 victory. Blakes then tallied 34 points in a 102-86 victory over No. 10 Oklahoma. The Somerset, New Jersey, native has scored 30-plus in three-straight games, which makes Blakes the first Commodore this century to accomplish the feat. The guard is just the fourth SEC player since 1999-00 to score 30 or more in three-consecutive contests. Her efforts this week have lifted the sophomore to the top of the NCAA Division I scoring list, as her 25.9 points per game leads the nation.

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate:
Vanderbilt freshman Aubrey Galvan averaged 23.0 points, 4.5 assists and 2.5 steals to help Vanderbilt to a pair of top-25 wins this week. Galvan opened her week by scoring

16 points in an 84-83 win at No. 16 Kentucky. The freshman point guard went a perfect 7-of-7 from the free throw line against the Wildcats. Galvan came up clutch down the stretch to help Vandy seal the top-25 road victory, as the point guard went 4-for-4 at the charity stripe in the final 25 seconds that allowed the Commodores to hold off UK. The Deerfield, Illinois, native had her best offensive outing at the collegiate level on Monday, as Galvan dropped 30 points on No. 10/11 Oklahoma to help the Commodores to a 102-86 victory. The freshman shot 66.7 percent from the floor against the Sooners, making 10 of her 15 shots. Galvan's 30 points are the most scored in an SEC game by a freshman this season, while it is the second-most points registered in a game by an SEC freshman in 2025-26.

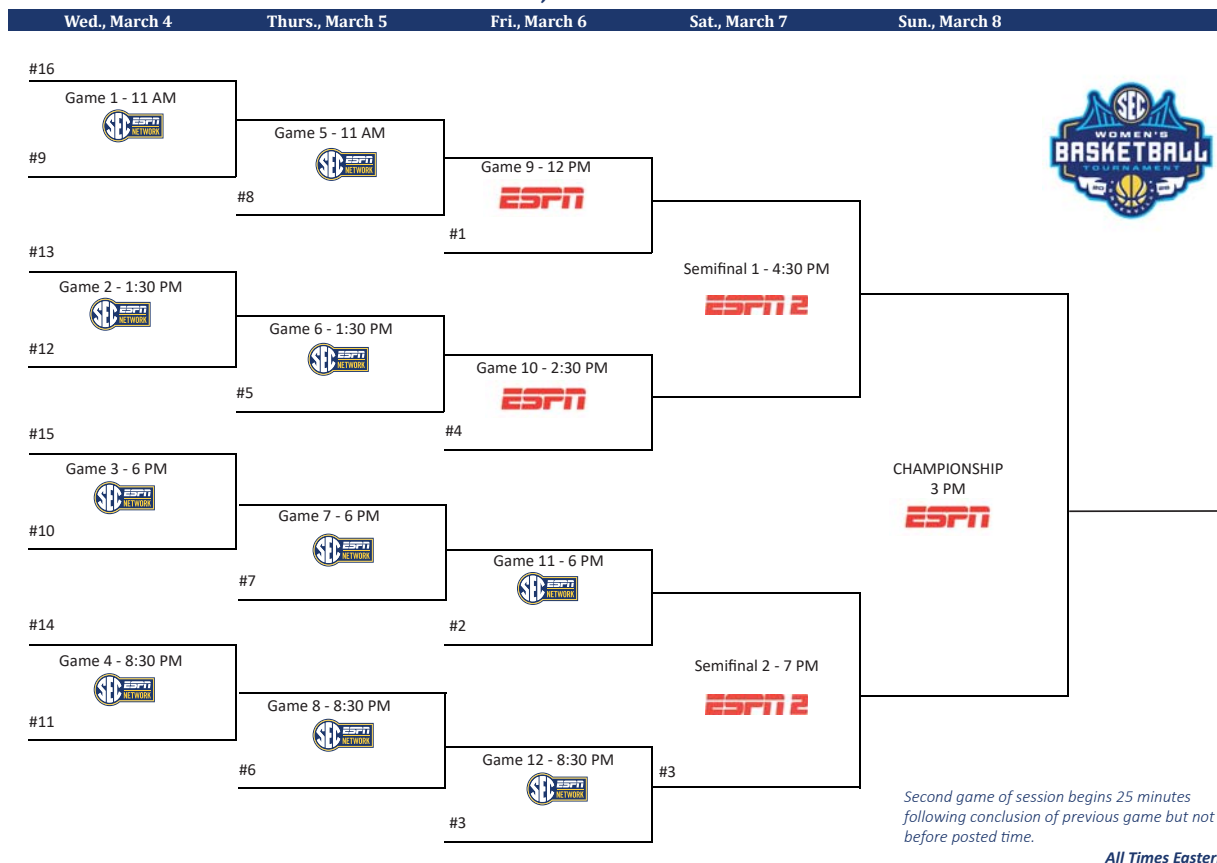

SEC Tournament

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024, 2025, 2026), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The conference announced a three-year extension with Greenville, S.C. to host the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament in through 2028.

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with nine, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
