## CONFERENCE NOTES

### Weekly Honors

• **SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate: Clara Strack, who was named the Naismith Trophy Player of the Week, led Kentucky in back-to-back Southeastern Conference wins on 22.5 points per game, 11.0 rebounds per game, 2.5 blocks per game and 1.5 assists per game, while shooting 50.0 percent from inside the arc during that stretch. More recently, she put up 28 points, nine rebounds, two blocks and an assist to help Kentucky take down No. 14/16 Ole Miss inside Historic Memorial Coliseum on Sunday. She became the first Kentucky player to record at least 28 points and nine rebounds against an Associated Press Top 15 team since Rhyne Howard at No. 12 Mississippi State on Jan. 3, 2021. It marked UK's third AP Top 15 win this season, which is the first time UK has notched three AP Top 15 wins in a regular season since 1982-83. Strack's scoring performance marked her sixth 20-plus point game of the season, which leads the team. Ten of her points came on 5-of-10 shooting in the fourth quarter to keep the Rebels from closing the gap. She also went 6-of-6 from the line in that game. The junior improved to 71 blocks, which is just two away from breaking her own single-season school record that she set as a sophomore with 73 in 2024-25. She is the only player in program history to put together two seasons with at least 70 blocks. Her 71 blocks and her 2.63 blocks per game are both third in the country. Prior to the Rebels, she helped the Wildcats defeat the Aggies on her 13th double-double of the season with 17 points and 13 rebounds. She also had three blocks and two assists in that game. She has dished out multiple assists in 17-of-27 games this season.

• **SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK** presented by Allstate: Madison Francis led the Bulldogs to back-to-back SEC wins for the first time this season, averaging a team-leading 15 points and 3.0 blocks, alongside 7.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 0.5 steals on the week. On the week, she shot 54.5 percent from the floor and 66.7 percent from distance. She started the week off with a 17-point, eight-rebound performance against Georgia, while shooting 58.3 percent from the floor and knocking down her only three-point attempt. She recorded four blocks, which marked the ninth time she has recorded four or more in a game, a total which leads

the nation. Francis now averages 2.8 blocks on the season, which continues to lead the league and rank second in the nation. Her 74 total blocks move her into eighth on Mississippi State's single-season block list. Francis scored 13 points, recorded seven rebounds, dished out three assists and rejected two shots in a victory over Arkansas in Fayetteville. Her two blocks led the team in the contest, marking the 18th time she has led the team in blocks this year. Francis tied her career-high with three three-pointers made. Francis was one of four Bulldogs to knock down three triples, marking the first time State has had four players hit three or more in a single game in at least 20 seasons.

### Around the League

- Freshman Aubrey Galvan, who finished with 20 points, hit a jump shot with only 7.9 seconds left in the game as McKayla Blakes finishes with 35 points to give the Commodores an 81-79 victory over the Kentucky.
- Ny'Ceara Pryor had 16 points with 12 assists and three steals while Fatmata Janneh added 11 points and 13 rebounds to lead the Aggies past the Razorbacks, 78-57.
- Jessica Timmons poured in a career-high 34 points as the Crimson Tide rallied in the fourth quarter to defeat the Gators, 76-71, and snap a three-game losing streak.
- Joyce Edwards scored 21 points while Madina Okot added 17 points to help the South Carolina clinch at least a share of the SEC title with an 85-48 victory over the Rebels.
- Madison Booker powered the offense with 23 points as Jordan Lee had 17, including five 3-pointers, to give the Longhorns a 92-42 win over Mississippi State.
- Raegan Beers recorded 18 points and 18 rebounds to help the Sooners survive the Lady Vols' offense with a 100-93 victory.
- MiLaysia Fulwiley earned her first career double-double with 22 points and 11 rebounds in LSU's win over Missouri.

**SEC Tournament Tie-Breaker Procedures**

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

**SEC SUCCESS**

**The Nation's Best Coaches**

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

**The Nation's Best Players**

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

**Women's Basketball Leadership Council**

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.
- The student-athletes who comprise the SEC Women's Basketball Leadership Council are: Jessica Timmons, Alabama; Jenna Lawrence, Arkansas; Ja'Mia Harris, Auburn; Laila Reynolds, Florida; Savannah Henderson, Georgia; Teonni Key, Kentucky; Izzy Besselman, LSU; Christeen Iwuala, Ole Miss; Chandler Prater, Mississippi State; Grace Slaughter, Missouri; Beatrice Culliton, Oklahoma; Maryam Dauda, South Carolina; Kaiya Wynn, Tennessee; Kyla Oldacre, Texas; Ny'Ceara Pryor, Texas A&M; Sacha Washington, Vanderbilt.

**Academics**

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

**By The Number**

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
