CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

SEC CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Senior center Madina Okot averaged a double-double for the week as South Carolina posted two top-25 victories last week to clinch at least a share of its fifth-straight SEC regular-season championship. Adding two double-doubles for the week, she has 17 on the season to rank 10th in program history with six of those coming against ranked opponents, which ties for the most in the nation this season and the most by a Gamecock since Aliyah Boston posted 12 in 2021-22. Of her 33 points last week, 15 came from the 3-point line, from which she was a perfect 5-of-5 on the week. Her three made 3s against Ole Miss on Sunday were the most by 6-foot-6 SEC player this century. Six of Okot's 10 rebounds against the Rebels were on the offensive end. At Alabama, Okot had her fourth-straight double-double by halftime with 13 points and 10 boards along with four blocks in 16 of the game's first 20 minutes as the Gamecocks built a 10-point lead at the break.

Vanderbilt's Mikayla Blakes recorded her fourth-straight 30-point game against a ranked team on Sunday, as the sophomore scored 35 points in an 81-79 victory over No. 16/18 Kentucky. The guard was efficient against the Wildcats, shooting 50 percent from the field (11-of-22) and from 3-point range (3-of-6), while she went 10-of-12 from the charity stripe. Blakes was clutch down the stretch, as she scored 11 points in the fourth quarter and went 5-of-6 from the free throw line. The All-American collected five rebounds, three assists and two steals in the victory. Blakes' 35 points against the Wildcats marked her 10th 30-point performance of the season. She is the first SEC player this century to have 10 30-point games in the same season, nine of which have come against conference foes. She is also the second SEC player in the last 15 seasons to have nine-straight 20-point games in league play.

SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK presented by Allstate:

Oklahoma's Aaliyah Chavez averaged 24.0 points on 47% shooting in a pair of ranked wins on the week. The guard opened the stretch with 27 points on 53% shooting to lead the Sooners past No. 24 Georgia in Athens, adding five as-

sists, four rebounds and two steals in the four-point win. Chavez went a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line in that game and followed it by going 10-for-10 at the line in Oklahoma's 100-93 victory over No. 21 Tennessee on Sunday, finishing with 21 points, four assists, three rebounds and two steals against the Lady Vols. Her 27-point performance against Georgia marked her sixth 25-point game of the season — more than all other SEC freshmen combined. The outing against Tennessee was her 10th 20-point game, the most among league freshmen. Chavez also tied the SEC record for consecutive free throws made, hitting her 47th straight on Sunday to match Ole Miss' Crystal Allen (2019).

Around the League

- Four teams in the nation have at least 18 wins over Division I opponents that currently have a winning record, three of which are from the SEC: South Carolina, Texas, Vanderbilt, UCLA.
- South Carolina, Texas and Vanderbilt are the nation's only teams with four wins over opponents ranked in the AP Top 10 at the time of game.
- South Carolina clinched its fifth straight Southeastern Conference title with a 112-71 victory over Missouri on Thursday night.

SEC Tournament Tie-Breaker Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 16 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 8 will receive first-round byes.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 9 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

1. Two-Team Tie: The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

2. Three-Team Tie (or more): When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used:

- A. Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B. Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed (and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary).
- C. Won-lost results in road Conference games.
- D. Head-to-head point differential (points scored minus points allowed) between the two tied teams.
- E. Winning percentage against all Quad 1 Division I opponents.
- F. Winning percentage against all Quad 2 Division I opponents.
- G. NCAA NET ranking (most recent available NET ranking before the conference tournament).

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Seven current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Jennie Baranczyk, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey, Dawn Staley, Joni Taylor and Shea Ralph).
- In addition, Abrahamson-Henderson and Harper have both taken four different teams to the tournament, while Kristy Curry has taken three different teams to the tournament.
- Jenni Baranczyk, Kenny Brooks, Yolett McPhee-McCuin, Kim Mulkey, Vic Schaefer, Dawn Staley and Joni Taylor have made the tournament with two different teams.

The Nation's Best Players

- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 17 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 83 players named first team a total of 182 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- Nine Naismith Player of the Year winners have come from the SEC. They include Saudia Roundtree, Georgia (1996), Chamique Holdsclaw, Tennessee (1998 and 1999), Tamika Catchings, Tennessee (2000), Seimone Augustus, LSU (2005 and 2006), Candace Parker, Tennessee (2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The SEC has had 178 former players play in the WNBA.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 204 former players drafted for the professional league, including eight No. 1 picks.
- The league has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).

Women's Basketball Leadership Council

- The council consists of one women's basketball student-athlete from each of the SEC's 16 institutions. The goal of the leadership council is for student-athletes to serve as a conduit of communication from their teams to the conference office on issues related to student-athlete experience, student-athlete wellness, and to provide feedback on proposed rules governing the SEC and NCAA.
- The student-athletes who comprise the SEC Women's Basketball Leadership Council are: Jessica Timmons, Alabama; Jenna Lawrence, Arkansas; Ja'Mia Harris, Auburn; Laila Reynolds, Florida; Savannah Henderson, Georgia; Teonni Key, Kentucky; Izzy Besselman, LSU; Christeen Iwuala, Ole Miss; Chandler Prater, Mississippi State; Grace Slaughter, Missouri; Beatrice Culliton, Oklahoma; Maryam Dauda, South Carolina; Kaiya Wynn, Tennessee; Kyla Oldacre, Texas; Ny'Ceara Pryor, Texas A&M; Sacha Washington, Vanderbilt.

Academics

- A total of 149 women's basketball students were named to the 2024-25 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 38 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).

By The Number

- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only six times to place at least five members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- In 2025, the most SEC teams in the final AP poll was eight, a record for the conference. Up until last season, seven was the most, which the league has done five times (1995, 1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- SEC schools have produced 48 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 44 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, 11 have played for other countries in the Olympics.
