## EAGLES SET FOR ROAD TEST AT VANDERBILT

Eastern looking to extend its winning streak to three

**NASHVILLE, Tenn. (EMUEagles.com)** -- The Eastern Michigan University lacrosse team will wrap up its four-game road trip Wednesday, March 4, when the Eagles put their two-game winning streak on the line in a game at Vanderbilt University. The Eagles (5-2), off to their best start in program history, and Commodores (2-3) will meet at 12 p.m. CT (1 p.m. ET) at the Vanderbilt Lacrosse Complex in Nashville, Tenn., with the game streaming live on ESPN+.

### OPENING DRAWS

- » Eastern is 5-2 overall and has won back-to-back road games, including a 13-10 victory at Austin Peay (March 1) after downing Oregon (Feb. 22), 12-9. The Eagles are looking to post their second, three-game win streak of the season with a win at Vanderbilt.
- » The game with Vanderbilt will mark the third opponent in 2026 Eastern will play for the first time after previously defeating Lindenwood at home (Feb. 11), 14-11, and Austin Peay on the road (March 1), 13-10. The fourth game will come April 11 at home against UMass in a MAC contest.
- » The win over Xavier (Feb. 14) extended EMU's home winning streak to three games and tied the program record set twice before. The first instance came with the final game of 2023 and the first two home contests of 2024 with the second consisting of three consecutive wins in 2025.
- » Eastern has been a team of two halves this year as the defense has allowed 54 goals in the first two quarters of play and only 30 total in the final two stanzas. The Eagles have held foes to four or fewer second half goals in 5-of-7 games with the exceptions coming against Lindenwood (six goals) and at Canisius (nine).
- » EMU has won four of its five games after trailing at some point, including twice when trailing in the fourth quarter. To aid in those wins, the defense held its opponent scoreless for more than 12 minutes in three of those contests, including the last three victories recorded (12:47 vs. Xavier, 19:00 at Oregon, 14:02 at Austin Peay).
- » In the win at Austin Peay, three milestones were achieved with two coming from **Tracy Grollman**, who recorded one goal and three assists. Her goal came on the advantage for her 10th career woman-up goal to make her only the second EMU player to reach double-digit advantage goals. She also tied the program record with her 45th career save. **Christie Evans** not only scored her first collegiate goal but also the 600th in team history.
- » **Emerson Henry** had the hot hand against Austin Peay as she scored a career-high five goals in the win, including two woman-up goals, which tied for the third-highest single-game total in program history. Henry, who tied her career high with five points, added eight draw controls as well.
- » Two freshmen recorded their first collegiate points on the final goal of the game as **Christie Evans** recorded her first goal and **Brooke Sganga** tallied her first assist.
- » **Emma Baker** made her collegiate debut as she played the fourth quarter in goal. The rookie goalkeeper allowed one goal and made three saves to help EMU erase a two-goal deficit and win by three.
- » **Tracy Grollman** was named the MAC Female Scholar-Athlete of the Week (Feb. 25) following her strong play in Oregon. The graduate student and member of the first recruiting class in program history, Grollman tallied four points on two goals and two assists to reach exactly 100 points in her career.
- » **Mackenzie Blackwell** has tallied 28 points this year on 20 goals and a career-high eight assists. She currently (as of March 2) ranks 15th nationally in goals scored (second in the MAC) and 23rd in total points (second).
- » Eastern is set to play 16 regular season games in 2026 with eight each being played at home and on the road. The schedule also features three games against teams from a 'Power 4' conference, including road games at Oregon (Big Ten) and Vanderbilt (SEC) and a home game with Cincinnati (Big 12).
- » Five Eagles were named captains for the 2026 season, including **Mackenzie Blackwell**, **Samantha Borgert**, **Kelsey Dague**, **Maddy Porter**, and **Annika Wozney**.
- » The team will feature 12 seniors, including nine that were part of the program's first major signing class in 2022. The group will be honored in Senior Day festivities following the game with Robert Morris, April 18.
- » The coaching staff also welcomed two new faces as **Irene Carlquist** and **Ty McGuire** were hired as assistant coaches. Carlquist, most recently the head coach at Lees-McRae, will work with the goalkeepers, while McGuire, the former head coach of the men's program at Concordia-Ann Arbor, will work with the defense.
- » **Maddie Dugan** is in her second season guiding the Eagles. The 2024 MAC Coach of the Year at Detroit Mercy, Dugan guided the Eagles to a share of the MAC regular season crown in 2025, the first title in program history.

### ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

For the second consecutive week, a member of the program was named the MAC Female Scholar-Athlete of the Week with **Tracy Grollman** earning the accolade (Feb. 25) after her four-point performance at Oregon helped the Eagles to their first win over a 'Power 4' program while also pushing her career total to 100 points. Grollman, who earned the honor one week after **Kelsea Dague** (Feb. 18), is the first player in program history to garner the award twice in a career after earning the award once last year.

**QUICK RECAP: APSU**

Eastern Michigan once again used a fourth quarter filled with strong defensive play and timely goals to erase a 10-8 deficit and capture a 13-10 win at Austin Peay, March 1. **Emerson Henry** scored a career-high five goals while **Tracy Grollman** tallied four points on one goal and three assists to pace the offense while rookie **Emma Baker** made her debut in goal in the fourth quarter where she made three saves to shut the door on the Governors. **Karly Low** and **Haley Hodak** combined for seven ground balls and three caused turnovers for a defense that held its fifth opponent of the year to four or fewer goals in the final half of play.

**BEST START**

With its win at Austin Peay (March 1), Eastern improved to 5-2 and set the record for best start in program history, surpassing the 4-3 record the 2025 team recorded one year ago. The five wins in seven games is two ahead of the previous pace as both the 2024 and 2025 teams recorded their fifth wins of the year in the ninth game of their respective seasons.

**TOUGH TO CLOSE OUT**

The Eagles have won five games in 2026 and trailed in four of those contests with only a wire-to-wire home win over Butler (Feb. 8) the outlier. Starting with the win over Lindenwood (Feb. 11), Eastern has trailed its opponent in each of the last five games and pulled out a win in four, including victories over Xavier (Feb. 14) and Austin Peay (March 1), when the Eagles trailed in the fourth quarter before claiming victory.

**RED LIGHT, GREEN LIGHT**

Eastern has held foes scoreless for long stretches in the fourth quarter in its past three victories while scoring goals to help complete come-from-behind wins. The win over Xavier (Feb. 14) saw the Eagles hold the Musketeers scoreless the final 12:47 of the game while scoring four goals to win, 9-7. On the road at Oregon, the Ducks tied the game at nine with four minutes to play in the third before EMU went on a 3-0 run over the final 19 minutes of play for the 12-9 win. Most recently, Eastern held Austin Peay (March 1) scoreless over the final 14:02 while going on a 5-0 run for the 13-10 win.

**A TALE OF TWO HALVES**

The Eagles have allowed 84 goals scored this year with 54 coming in the first half and only 30 in the second. In fact, in five of those games, an opponent has scored more than four goals just twice as Lindenwood tallied six in EMU's 14-11 win while Canisius scored nine in the Eagles' road loss in Buffalo.

**POWER OUTAGE**

The 2026 season features a trio of games against 'Power 4' foes with the Eagles' game at Vanderbilt the second of those contests. On Feb. 22, Eastern traveled to Eugene, Ore., and snagged a 12-9 win over the Oregon Ducks, marking the first 'Power 4' win in program history and snapping a seven-game slide in such games. Prior to the game, Eastern had previously faced members of the Big Ten in Michigan (0-3) and Oregon (1-1), Notre Dame (0-2) of the ACC, and Cincinnati (0-1) of the Big 12. Following the game with the Commodores, Eastern will entertain Cincinnati (March 8), which will provide Eastern another chance to 'Fly the Flag' (the MAC's designation for defeating a 'Power 4' team in any sport utilizing a black flag featuring the MAC shield over crossbones).

**COLLECTING REAL ESTATE**

Prior to winning at Oregon (Feb. 22), the furthest West the Eagles had won a game came with their win in Indiana at Butler last year (March 7). With the win over Austin Peay (March 1), the Eagles have now won at least one game in eight states, including Michigan, Delaware, Indiana, North Carolina, Ohio, Oregon, South Carolina, and Tennessee, as well as Washington D.C.

**KNOW THE FOE: VANDERBILT**

The Commodores are 2-3 with all three losses coming to nationally ranked foes, including No. 12 Clemson (20-5), No. 2 Stanford (18-6), and No. 17 Denver (19-7) with the latter two being played at home. Vanderbilt has won twice at home, including a 14-11 victory over Mercer and a 22-10 defeat of Cincinnati, in its most recent game (Feb. 27). Nancy Halleron leads the team with 19 points on a team-best 16 goals and three assists while Shea Panzik is second with 16 points while leading with 10 assists and adding six goals. Emme Martin has started all five games in goal where she has saved 31.9 percent of the shots she has faced, recording 30 saves and allowing 14.76 goals per game.

**IN THE SERIES: EAGLES vs. COMMODORES**

Eastern and Vanderbilt are meeting for the first time.

**THIRD OF FOUR FIRSTS**

The game at Vanderbilt will mark the second consecutive game and third overall in 2026 that Eastern Michigan will play a team for the first time in program history. Already this year, the Eagles have defeated Lindenwood at home (Feb. 11), 14-11, and are coming off a 13-10 win at Austin Peay (March 1). The fourth of the four new opponents in 2026 comes April 11 when UMass comes to Ypsilanti for a Mid-American Conference game at Scicluna Field.

**TAKING ON • THE AMERICAN**

Vanderbilt plays in the American Conference (formerly the American Athletic Conference) for lacrosse, a league that also includes Charlotte, East Carolina, James Madison, Old Dominion, South Florida, and Temple. The game at Vanderbilt will mark the first time the Eagles have played a member of the American.

**ADDED TO THE LIST**

Two more Eagles recorded their first career points with each earning those points on the same goal as **Brooke Sganga** assisted on **Christie Evans'** goal with 2:28 to play at Austin Peay. Both players were making their collegiate debuts and joined **Emma Reichert** and **Reagan Riemer** on the list as they scored one goal and dished one assist, respectively, against Lindenwood (Feb. 11). Three other Eagles posted career first earlier in the season as **Mak Grisinger** scored her first goal while **Erin Humphrey** and **Kendall Nagle** each recorded their first career assists.

**MAKE IT MORE MEMORABLE**

The goal scored by **Christie Evans** and assisted by **Brooke Sganga** at 2:28 to play in the fourth quarter at Austin Peay will be memorable for the freshmen as their first collegiate points. Additionally, it will go down in another historical chapter as the goal stands as the 600th scored in program history.

**NEW BRICKS**

At the start of the fourth quarter at Austin Peay, freshman **Emma Baker** was brought on to play goalkeeper and performed exceptionally well as she recorded three saves and one goal allowed in her 15 minutes of play. Baker, who entered the game with EMU trailing, held the Governors scoreless over the final 14:02 to pick up the victory.

## EMU HEAD COACH MADDIE DUGAN

**Maddie Dugan** enters her second season in charge of the Eastern Michigan University lacrosse program in 2026 and looks to build off a successful debut campaign that saw the Eagles earn a share of the Mid-American Conference regular season crown, the first in program history. Dugan has guided her teams to the MAC Tournament in both seasons as the Eagles were the No. 2 seed in 2025 after she led the University of Detroit Mercy to the final of the 2024 tournament after being named the MAC Coach of the Year.

The third head coach in program history, Dugan's debut season saw EMU post an 8-9 record and a 4-2 mark in the MAC to earn a share of the regular season crown and the No. 2 seed in the tournament. The Eagles, who rebounded from two losses to open the season with a program-record four consecutive wins, were paced by **Mackenzie Blackwell**, the 2025 MAC Attacker of the Year, and **Maddy Porter**, the 2025 MAC Goalkeeper of the Year. Both ranked among the top players in the conference and were joined as All-MAC First Team honorees by defender **Annika Wozney**.

Individually, Blackwell the MAC in goals (59) and was second in points (65), both of which set single-season EMU records, while Porter led the way with 179 saves and 71 ground balls. Porter's scoops marked the second year in a row in which he led all NCAA Division I players in ground balls after securing 63 in 2024. Freshman **Emerson Henry** made an immediate impact as well as the 2025 All-MAC Second-Team selection was second in the MAC with 94 draw controls won, a mark that tied the school record. She also ranked 41st nationally.

As a team, the Eagles also ranked among the best nationally in several statistical categories, including 11th in save percentage (.483) and 13th in fewest fouls committed (10.12). On the conference level, the Eagles ranked among the top three in all categories tracked by the league as well.

In her lone season leading the Titans, she was named the MAC Coach of the Year as Detroit Mercy was picked to finish last in the coaches' poll but made the playoffs and advanced to the championship game where it fell, 14-11, to Robert Morris University. UDM ended the year by making the postseason for the first time since 2019 and its first postseason win and championship appearance since 2016. The six wins and three victories on the road were also the most since 2019.

Dugan worked with several top players in the MAC, including Cat Kopchia, the 2024 MAC Offensive Player of the Year and an All-MAC First Team selection, with four other Titans earning placement on the All-MAC Second Team. Additionally, 13 of her student-athletes were named to the MAC All-Academic Team and the program recorded a 3.47 GPA during the year. The 2024 season marked the second Dugan spent in Detroit as she served as an assistant coach during the 2022 campaign, working with the offense and draw specialists.

Between her two seasons with the Titans, Dugan spent 2023 at The Woodlands High School in The Woodlands, Texas, where she led the team to a 9-4 overall record and was ranked first in Houston and sixth in the state, advancing to the quarterfinals for the state tournament. Her players earned six All-District, four All-State and one Academic All-American accolade, as well as one player honored with the Jackie Pitts Award, which recognizes seniors who go above and beyond in service to their team, school, and community.

From 2017-21, Dugan was the head coach of the program at Trine University, an NCAA Division III program in Angola, Ind. During her five seasons leading the Thunder, Dugan helped rebuild the program during her tenure with the team, steadily increasing its win total in her first three years as head coach. She helped the 2019 squad to its most wins since the 2011 season and coached three players to all-conference awards in three of her final four seasons with the program. During her final season as head coach at Trine, the squad reached the MIAA Tournament quarterfinals. The Thunder set numerous single-season and career records for points, goals, assists and draw controls, among other records. Her Trine squads were also standouts in the classroom as she coached 31 total student-athletes to MIAA Academic Honor Roll laurels (3.5 GPA or higher) and the 2020 and 2021 squads had team GPAs of 3.61 and 3.60, respectively.

She began her coaching career at Wartburg College (Iowa) in 2014-15 as an assistant coach, where she helped establish a first-year program. She helped coach the team to a 3-4 mark in conference play in its first season of competition. She returned to her Alma mater at Adrian College as an assistant coach in 2015-16 and helped coach the team to a four-win improvement from the previous season. Dugan worked primarily with the attackers and helped the Bulldogs accumulate 9.8 goals per game and 192 total points, an 81-point improvement from the previous season.

### OH HENRY!

**Emerson Henry** was the offensive catalyst for the Eagles in their 13-10 come-from-behind win as she scored five goals for five points while adding eight draw controls. Her five goals, which surpassed the four she scored against Akron (April 20, 2025) at home, marked her fourth career hat trick and bettered her season high of two goals scored at Oregon one game prior. Her five goals, which tied for the eighth-most in a single game in EMU history, included two woman-up goals, which tied for the third-highest total in program history. Additionally, Henry posted a season-high eight draw controls and was one shy of her season high of nine recorded against Butler (Feb. 8). Henry also recorded her fourth career game with a hat trick while also posting at least five draw controls won, giving EMU a 3-1 record in those contests.

### HAPPIEST OF HELPERS

**Tracy Grollman** finished the game at Austin Peay (March 1) with four points on one goal and three assists. With her hat trick of helpers, Grollman brought her career total to 45, which tied Avery Schwab (2023-25) for the all-time record in program history. Her second game of the season with a trio of assists (at Marquette, Feb. 6), Grollman has now recorded three or more assists in nine career games.

### GROLLMAN HITS CENTURY MARK

**Tracy Grollman** recorded four points on two goals and two assists at Oregon (Feb. 22) to bring her career total to 100 points (now at 104), making her only the second player in program history to reach the century mark. Grollman, who recorded her sixth career game with multiple goals and multiple assists in the same contest, tied her season-high in points she set at Marquette in the opener (Feb. 6).

### NEAR THE TOP OF THE (COLLEGIATE) WORLD

Following games played March 1, **Mackenzie Blackwell** continues to rank among the best nationally as she holds three rankings among the top 30, including standing 15th in NCAA Division I with 20 goals. She also ranks 23rd in points with 28 while sitting 26th in shots per game with 7.00. On a conference level, Blackwell has her name listed in the top 10 of seven categories, including second in both goals and points, fourth in goals per game (2.86), points per game (4.00), shots per game, and draw controls per game (3.86), while rankings ninth in assists per game (1.14).

### PORTER ON THE RISE

**Maddy Porter** also ranks highly in two national categories, including saves, where her 54 stops are eighth in NCAA Division I. Porter also ranks 50th in saves per game (7.17).

### YOU'RE GROUNDED

**Karly Low** is ranked 43rd nationally in ground balls per game as she is averaging 2.71 per contest. The junior collected three ground balls in the game at Austin Peay, marking her second consecutive game with at least three, while scooping at least one ground ball in all seven games played in 2026. Additionally, she has added at least one caused turnover in all seven games this year, too.

### MORE ON THE LIST

**Emerson Henry** also ranks among the top 10 in the MAC as her 3.00 draw controls per contest rank eighth. She tallied eight in the game at Austin Peay, which was one shy of her season-high nine recorded Butler (Feb. 8). All told, Henry has posted eight or more draw controls in a single game eight times in her career.

### NATIONALLY KNOWN • TEAM RANKINGS

As a team, Eastern is among the top 50 in three statistical categories (through games played March 1), led by the team's 17.86 ground balls per game, which rank 18th nationally. The Eagles also rank 33rd in caused turnovers per game (9.71) and 39th in draw controls per game (13.00).

## MILESTONE HUNTING - BLACKWELL

**Mackenzie Blackwell** is the program's career leader in nine categories, including goals (167), hat tricks (34), game-winning goals (six), free-position goals (27), woman-up goals (37), points (188), shots (358), shots on goal (260), and draw controls (249) through the game played at Austin Peay (March 1). The only player in program history to reach 100 and 150 goals and the first of two to reach 100 points, Blackwell is nearing another stellar milestone as she needs just one draw control win to reach 250. Additionally, she is chasing 200 career points as she needs just 12 more.

## MORE THAN HATS

To reach her goals and points totals, **Mackenzie Blackwell** has scored goals in bunches for the Eagles throughout her career. Blackwell has played in all 56 games in program history and has scored at least one goal in 87.3 percent of the games she has played with 78.6 percent of her games ending with multiple goals. Here is how she has fared throughout her career:

- » 1+ goals: 49-of-56 games (.875 percent)
- » 2+ goals: 44-of-56 games (.786)
- » 3+ goals: 34-of-56 games (.607)
- » 4+ goals: 21-of-56 games (.375)
- » 5+ goals: 9-of-56 games (.161)

## MORE MILESTONES AHEAD

A handful of Eagle are approaching career milestones as well as several look to reach new heights in goals, points, and caused turnovers. Here is who is moving closer to higher marks:

- » Goals: **Abby Alderman** has tallied 48 goals in her career and needs two more to become only the fourth player in EMU history to reach 50.
- » Points: Three Eagles are approaching 50 career points with **Emerson Henry** at 49, **Katheryn Wilson** at 47, and **Kelsea Dague** at 43. The trio currently ranks seventh, eighth, and ninth, respectively, on the program's top 10 ledger.
- » Caused Turnovers: **Annika Wozney**, who has started on defense in all 55 of EMU's games, has collected 42 caused turnovers, leaving her eight away from becoming just the second player to reach 50 and nine away from tying **Sydney Lawrence** (2023-24) for the record (51).

## SHE CAN DIG IT

**Maddy Porter** achieved her second career milestone of the season during the victory at Oregon (Feb. 22) as the junior goalkeeper collected one ground ball to bring her career total to 150, making her the first player in program history to reach the milestone mark after becoming the first to reach 100 as well. Ranked first among all current NCAA Division I players for career ground balls per game average (3.9), Porter previously recorded her 350th career save in the game at Canisius (Feb. 18).

## AHOY, CAPTAINS!

Five Eagles were selected as team captains for the 2026 season. The captains include **Mackenzie Blackwell**, **Samantha Borgert**, **Kelsea Dague**, **Maddy Porter**, and **Annika Wozney**.

## ON THE HORIZON

Eastern returns to action Sunday, March 8, with its first outdoor home game of 2026 as the Eagles will welcome the Bearcats of the University of Cincinnati to Scicluna Field in Ypsilanti. The game is scheduled for a 12 p.m. start and will be streamed live on ESPN+ with Ben Holden and Lindsey Chase on the call.

## PREVIOUSLY NOTED

### HAVING ANOTHER BIG DAGUE

After sitting out the 2025 season with an injury, **Kelsea Dague** has made the most of her return to the field as she ranks second on the team in goals scored (11), third in points (12), and leads the squad with two game-winning goals after recording her second in the win at Oregon (Feb. 22). Dague has been in great form in recent weeks as she has scored multiple goals in each of the last four contests, including hat tricks against Lindenwood (Feb. 11), Xavier (Feb. 14), and Oregon while adding two at Canisius (Feb. 18). Through the game with the Ducks, Dague ranks second on the team with three hat tricks and has brought her career total to five while moving into a tie with **Caitlin Beahm** for second on the program's list of all-time game-winning goals with three.

### A CAUSED (TURNOVER) FOR CELEBRATION

In the game with Lindenwood and Xavier, the Eagles were disruptive as the team has tallied 27 caused turnovers in those games. It started with 13 against Lindenwood (Feb. 11), then tied for the sixth-highest total in a single game in program history before being bumped one spot following the game with Xavier (Feb. 14) where EMU recorded 14, which tied for the third-highest. Overall, 11 Eagles recorded at least one caused turnover while five tallied at least four, including five from **Karly Low** and four each from **Erin Humphrey**, **Payton Bloedow**, and **Maddy Porter**. Against Canisius, Low and **Haley Hodak** continued their disruptive play as they both recorded two caused turnovers while adding two ground balls each to mark the third consecutive game both have tallied at least two in both categories.

### DEFENDING HOME TURF

The Eagles played three home games in seven days and emerged with a perfect 3-0 record. The three consecutive wins broke the record for best home start after the 2024 team opened at 2-0 before falling to visiting No. 5 Michigan (20-4). Eastern will look to extend its home winning streak March 8 when Cincinnati comes to town.

### HOME STREAKING

With the win over Xavier (Feb. 14), the Eagles recorded their third consecutive home win to tie the record set twice previously and just once prior in the same season. The first streak began with the final game of the 2023 season, a 17-12 defeat of Detroit Mercy, and continued through the first two home games of 2024, which included a 15-8 win over Butler and 12-11 defeat of Kent State. Last year, the Eagles won three in a row at home with wins over Canisius (12-10), Youngstown State (19-6), and Detroit Mercy (13-8).

### ADDING TO THE STREAK?

While Eastern will have to wait until March to try and extend its home winning streak, it can tie the record for consecutive wins overall with a victory at Canisius. A win for the Eagles over the Golden Griffins would give Eastern four consecutive wins for just the second time in program history after the 2025 squad set the mark. After starting the year 0-2, the Eagles went on the road and defeated Presbyterian (19-10) and Gardner-Webb (16-6) before returning home to hand Canisius a 12-10 setback. The streak concluded with a 10-4 win at Butler as the Eagles fell at Cincinnati two days later, 13-9.

## FEELING HONORED

Following games played last weekend (Feb. 15), three members of the team were selected for Mid-American Conference weekly honors with **Kelsea Dague** being named the MAC Offensive Player of the Week, **Karly Low** the MAC Defensive Player of the Week, and **Maddy Porter** the MAC Goalkeeper of the Week.

- » Dague scored seven points on six goals and one assist in two games with each of those her first since the 2024 season after sitting out the 2025 campaign with an injury. She also scored her first two hat tricks since April 14, 2024, when she scored four against Central Michigan at home.
- » Low collected seven ground balls and four caused turnovers in two games, including a career-high five ground balls against Xavier, in a pair of wins. In the two games, the Eagles limited the visitors to 18 total goals, including just seven to Xavier.
- » Porter stopped 18 shots and grabbed 10 ground balls, four caused turnovers, and the first draw control of her career. She limited Xavier to just seven goals, including two in the second half and zero in the final 12:47 of the game.

## ADDING ANOTHER

Not only was **Kelsea Dague** named the MAC Offensive Player of the Week (Feb. 16), but she also was selected as the MAC Female Scholar-Athlete of the Week (Feb. 20). Dague was selected among all female student-athletes currently in competition and was eligible by maintaining at least a 3.0 grade-point average while excelling athletically. She is the third player in program history to earn the weekly academic honor after **Mackenzie Blackwell** (April 9, 2025) and **Tracy Grollman** (April 22, 2025) earned the first two in 2025.

## BIG GAME FOR 'BER

**Amber Alderman** had a career game at Canisius (Feb. 18) as she poured in four goals, surpassing her previous career-best of three goals scored in her freshman season at Youngstown State (April 8, 2023). Alderman, who entered the game with one goal on the season, tallied her fifth career game with multiple goals and her first since May 2, 2024, when she scored two in the semifinals of the MAC Tournament against Robert Morris. She also tallied four points in the game to bring her career total to 53 and become just the sixth player in EMU history to surpass 50 points.

## BRICK WALLS

The Eagles hosted three games (Feb. 8-14) and allowed an average of just 8.6 goals per game, including eight to Butler, 11 to Lindenwood, and seven to Xavier. Combined, Eastern added eight marks into its record book for fewest goals allowed with all three games appearing on the list for home games, including the seven goals allowed to Xavier tied for second; the eight to Butler tying for fourth; and the 11 to Lindenwood tying for ninth. When looking at all locations, the seven allowed to the Musketeers tied for sixth-fewest all-time while the eight the Bulldogs scored tied for ninth.

When looking at halves of play, the two goals surrendered to Xavier in the second half (one each in the third and fourth quarters) tied for the fifth-fewest in any game EMU has played while also tying for third for a home game in the second half. Additionally, the four goals scored by Butler in the fourth quarter tied for the eighth-lowest total for the second half of a home game in EMU history.

## MILESTONE: DRAW 100

**Emerson Henry** closed out her freshman season in 2025 with 94 draw controls, which tied for the single-season record in program history and took the top spot in the freshman record book. Henry, who tallied 12 draw controls on the weekend, including nine against Butler, recorded her 100th with the third draw control won against the Bulldogs. With 106, Henry is third all-time in EMU history with **Mackenzie Blackwell** (228) and **Abby Alderman** (126) the only two ahead of her.

## LIFTING LIDS • SEASON OPENERS

With their 20-9 loss at Marquette, Feb. 6, the Eagles fell to 0-4 all-time in their season-opening game and 0-4 in its first road contest of the season. Additionally, the 12-8 win over Butler, Feb. 8, pushed the Eagles to 2-2 all-time in their home opener with both wins coming against Butler (2024 and 2026).

## GROUNDING POWER

In its first three seasons, Eastern holds a 0-7 record against teams from the 'Power 4' conferences, a group of football conferences that include the ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, and SEC. The 2026 schedule will see the Eagles face three 'power' foes with games against Oregon (Big Ten) and Vanderbilt (SEC) on the road and Cincinnati (Big 12) at home. The loss at home to Oregon last year, 13-11, was the closest the Eagles have come to downing a 'power' conference foe.

## LOOKING AHEAD • 2026 SCHEDULE

Eastern will play 16 regular season games with eight each at home and on the road. After opening on the road at Marquette (Feb. 6), the Eagles will play three consecutive home games that include tilts with Butler (Feb. 8), Lindenwood (Feb. 11), and Xavier (Feb. 14). Eastern then will play four consecutive road games that will see the team venture to New York to face Canisius (Feb. 18), Oregon to face Oregon (Feb. 22), and Tennessee to face both Austin Peay (March 1) and Vanderbilt (March 4). Back-to-back home games await the Eagles thereafter with Cincinnati (March 8) and a MAC opener with Kent State (March 14) on the slate before two more road games await EMU with trips to Detroit Mercy (March 19) and Akron (March 28). The final three home games come in succession to open April with contests against Central Michigan (April 4), UMass (April 11), and Robert Morris (April 18) on Senior Day before the regular season ends at Youngstown State (April 25). The MAC Tournament will be played April 30 (semifinals) and May 2 (final) in Moon Township, Pa.

## PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

The MAC released its preseason coaches poll, Feb. 4, with the Eagles voted to finish tied for second with Akron as both received 37 points. League newcomer UMass was named the favorite to win with 48 points and six first-place votes with the remaining two first-place votes going to EMU and Robert Morris with one each. The Colonials, last year's tournament champion, earned 34 points to rank fourth with Central Michigan fifth (28 points), Kent State sixth (19), Youngstown State seventh (12), and Detroit Mercy eighth (nine). The coaches also voted on who they think will capture the MAC Tournament crown (April 30 & May 2 in Moon Township, Pa.) with UMass securing six votes and both EMU and host RMU garnering one each.

## BACK FOR MORE

**Mackenzie Blackwell** is no stranger to program records as she entered the 2025 season as the record holder in seven different categories, all of which she set in 2024. She reset the record in five categories in 2025, including:

- » 59 goals (was 49)
- » 13 hat tricks (was 10)
- » 65 points (was 54)
- » 132 shots (was 89)
- » 86 shots on goal (was 72)

## FIRST CLASS

In the first three years of the program, Senior Day consisted of honoring a total of 10 players, including one in 2023, five in 2024, and four last year. This year, that number balloons to 12 as the first full class of Eagles to join the program will be recognized. The class will feature nine players that began their careers at EMU together, including **Abby Alderman**, **Amber Alderman**, **Mackenzie Blackwell**, **Samantha Borgert**, **Gina D'Alessio**, **Kyleigh Dill**, **Haley Hodak**, **Maggie McCabe**, and **Annika Wozney**. Additionally, **Tracy Grollman**, who was recognized last year, is back for redshirt senior season while two players that transferred into the program, **Payton Bloedow** (2025-26) and **Sanai James** (2026), will also be recognized.

## HELLO! MY NAME IS...

The 2026 roster also features 12 newcomers, including 11 freshmen and one senior transfer, **Sanai James**, who spent the past three seasons with Delaware State. The rookie class, who have players hailing from seven states and two Canadian provinces, includes: **Emma Baker**, **Ashley Culin**, **Christie Evans**, **Zola LeDonne**, **Reagan Morrison**, **Ainsley Owens**, **Ashley Poquette**, **Emma Reichert**, **Brooke Sganga**, **Paige Sutton**, and **Ella Toth**.

## NEW TO THE CREW

New players were not the only additions to the roster ahead of the 2026 season as two new assistant coaches have joined **Maddie Dugan's** coaching staff. Both **Irene Carlquist** and **Ty McGuire** bring previous coaching experiences with them to Ypsilanti including stints as head coaches and assistants. Carlquist, a goalkeeper as a player at Indianapolis (2015-19), was the head coach at Lees-McRae for two years before coming to Eastern and also served as the head coach at Clarke University (2023) and Fishers High School (2022) after working as an assistant coach at Anderson University (2020-22). McGuire, an EMU graduate, spent the past seven years leading the men's program at Concordia-Ann Arbor, where he guided them to the NAIA Tournament three times. He also has served as an assistant coach at Kalamazoo College while serving in various roles at local high schools, including Dexter, Hartland, Chelsea, and Grand Blanc.

## AWARD WINNERS

All five Eagles that earned awards from the MAC at the conclusion of the 2025 season are back this year, including 2025 MAC Attacker of the Year **Mackenzie Blackwell** and 2025 Goalkeeper of the Year **Maddy Porter**. Blackwell (attack), Porter (goalkeeper) and Annika Wozney (defense) each were named All-MAC First Team honorees while Emerson Henry (midfield) was named All-MAC Second Team. Henry and **Katheryn Wilson** were both named to the MAC All-Freshman Team while Blackwell and Porter earned placements on the MAC All-Tournament Team.

## LOOKING BACK • 2025 SEASON

Eastern Michigan finished the 2025 regular season with an 8-8 record and a 4-2 mark in the MAC that placed it in a three-way tie for conference's regular season tilt with Akron and Robert Morris. As the No. 2 seed in the MAC Tournament, EMU fell to Akron to see its 2025 season come to a close.

The Eagles started the season 0-2 before bouncing back with four consecutive wins, marking the longest win streak in program history. After two consecutive losses, including a tough 10-9 loss at Robert Morris in the MAC opener, EMU rebounded with a 19-6 win at Youngstown State to draw its record even once again. Two more losses followed before the Eagles downed Detroit Mercy, 13-8. Following a close, 13-11, loss at home to Oregon, the Eagles won two in a row in MAC play to finish 4-2 in league action before dropping their regular season finale to Marquette, 18-14.

## CHAMPIONS!

For the first time in the program's three-year history, the Eagles are MAC Champions! Eastern posted a 4-2 record in league play with its only losses coming in one-goal road games at Robert Morris (March 16) and Central Michigan (March 30). Both Akron and Robert Morris posted 4-2 records as well following the Zips' home win over the Colonials on the final day of the regular season to force a three-way tie for the crown. While the title stands as the first for the Eagles, it marks the 159th MAC crown earned by an EMU team and continues a streak of 44 consecutive years Eastern has secured at least one conference title in an academic year.

## RECORD BREAKERS • TEAM

The Eagles broke 15 team records in 2025, including: wins (8), goals (198), hat tricks (27), game-winning goals (8), free-position goals (39), woman-down goals (3), assists (88), points (286), shots (474), shots on goal (330), ground balls (298), caused turnovers (141), goals against average (11.36), saves (180), and save percentage (.483).

## RECORD BREAKERS • INDIVIDUAL

Individually, 11 season records were tied or broken in 2025 as well. **Mackenzie Blackwell** increased her school records in five categories, including goals (59), hat tricks (13), points (65), shots (132), and shots on goal (86) while **Maddy Porter** took the top spot in four categories, including ground balls (71), saves (179), saves per game (10.53), and save percentage (.485). **Payton Bloedow** tallied two woman-down goals to become the first EMU player with multiple down goals in a single season while **Emerson Henry** tied for the draw control record (94) that Blackwell set in 2024. Henry's total also broke an EMU freshman record.

## PORTER'S ICE CREAM PARLOR

**Maddie Porter** is no stranger to scooping up ground balls as has finished as the NCAA leader in per game average in each of her first two collegiate seasons. Last year, she collected 71 ground balls for an average of 4.18 one year after securing 63 for an average of 4.20. Following the 2025 season, Porter's 4.19 per game average ranked first among all active NCAA Division I players and sixth among all collegiate players active during the season while 134 career ground balls ranked 15th among NCAA Division I players.
